

City Council Meeting
August 13, 1990

The City Council of the Town of Pine Mountain met in regular session on the evening of August 13, 1990 at seven o'clock P. M. in the City Hall.

Mayor James V. Edgar presided with Councilpersons J. R. Beall, Franklin D. Boykin, P. C. Holladay, Vance C. Smith and Patricia E. Sullivan in attendance.

Minutes - July 9, 1990:

Upon motion by Ms. Sullivan, seconded by Mr. Holladay and agreed to by all, the minutes of the July 9, 1990 meeting were approved as written.

Ordinance to Amend the Charter of the Town of Pine Mountain:

Mayor Edgar read an Ordinance to Amend the Charter of the Town of Pine Mountain. Mr. Holladay made a motion to accept the ordinance as read. Mr. Smith seconded the motion and the vote for adoption was unanimous.

Ordinance to Annex Certain Land in Town - First Reading:

Mayor Edgar gave the first reading of an ordinance to annex certain land in the Town.

Ordinance Establishing Service Districts - First Reading:

Mayor Edgar gave the first reading of an ordinance establishing service districts.

Ordinance to Approve the Execution of a City Contract - First Reading:

Mayor Edgar gave the first reading of an ordinance to approve the execution of a City contract.

Sewer Expansion Project:

Mr. Beall made a motion that Mayor Edgar be authorized to act as the agent of the Town of Pine Mountain to borrow up to \$350,000.00 for the construction phase of the sewer extension project. This loan is to be secured by the Farmers' Home Administration.

Mr. Holladay seconded the motion and the vote to approve was unanimous.

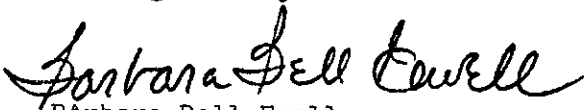
Depository of Funds:
