

ACTS OF THE COUNCIL
December 10, 1990

The Town Council of the Town of Pine Mountain met in regular session on the evening of December 10, 1990 at seven o'clock P M in the Town Hall.

Mayor James V Edgar presided with Councilpersons J R Beall, Franklin D Boykin, P C Holladay, Vance C Smith and Patricia E Sullivan in attendance.

Sewer Project - A E Naut:

Mr A E Naut appeared before the Council, to ask questions concerning connection to the sewer system. Mr. Naut also asked that a check valve be installed in his line since his home is at least three feet lower than others on the line.

Sewer Project - Pre-construction Hearing:

Mayor Edgar announced to the Council that the Pre-construction Hearing for the FmHA loan phase of the project was held Wednesday, December 5, 1990 in the Town Hall.

Pawn Brokers License - Application and Fee:

Mayor Edgar read an application for a pawn brokers license from Raymond H Reames, Jr.

Chief of Police Carl David White recommended a fee of \$300.00 be set as the purchase price of a license.

Ms Sullivan made a motion to set the fee at \$300.00 as recommended by the Chief of Police.

Mr Beall seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous.

JMERS - Ordinance:

Mayor Edgar announced that the Joint Municipal Employees' Retirement System is requesting that all member cities enact a new ordinance of adoption.

Ms Sullivan made a motion to approve the ordinance.

Mr Boykin seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous.

Annexation - Callaway Gardens Resort, Inc.:

Mayor Edgar announced to the Council that communication has been received from the United States Department of Justice and there are no objections to the annexation.

Budget - Addition:

Mayor Edgar recommended that the category of Legal Fees be amended from \$5,000.00 to \$10,000.00.

Mr Beall made a motion to so increase the budget.

Mr Smith seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous.

Christmas Bonuses - Employees:

Mr Boykin made a motion that the Christmas bonuses for supervisors be raised to \$100.00 and for employees to be raised to \$50.00. Mr Boykin further moved that the bonuses be for whatever amount that would result in an even \$100.00 and \$50.00 after deductions.

Ms Sullivan seconded and the vote was unanimous.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned.
