

ACTS OF THE COUNCIL
February 12, 1990

The Town Council of the Town of Pine Mountain met in regular session on the evening of February 12, 1990 at seven o'clock P. M. in the Town Hall.

Mayor James V Edgar presided with Councilpersons J R Beall, Franklin D Boykin, P C Holladay, Vance C Smith and Patricia E Sullivan in attendance.

Acts of the Council - January 8, 1990:

Upon motion by Ms Sullivan, seconded by Mr Holladay and agreed upon by all, the acts of January 8, 1990 were approved as written.

H A Mullins:

Mr H A Mullins appeared before the Council to inquire if a license is required to place a political sign on private property. It was explained that the Town has no ordinance covering signs on private property.

Gym Renovation:

Ms Lisa Baird appeared before the Council to request permission to initiate a project of renovation of the gym.

Mr Court Dowis also appeared before the council to explain the plans he has drawn for the renovation.

Ms Sullivan made a motion that Ms Baird be given permission to go ahead with the project.

Mr Smith seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous.

Sealed Bid - Survey of Town Limits:

Mayor Edgar opened a sealed bid from Hugh Riley and Associates for the survey of the Town Limits in the amount of \$8,500.00.

During the ensuing discussion, it was discovered that Mr Earl Phillips, who conducted the original survey of the town limits, has offered to locate the pins.

Mr Holladay made a motion that Mr Phillips be asked to locate the pins.

Mr Smith seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous.

Request - Use of Police Station for Religious Meetings:

Mayor Edgar read a letter from Pastor Don Richards of the Seventh Day Adventist Church in Pine Mountain Valley, Georgia requesting the use of the auditorium in the police station for a series of meetings.

Ms Sullivan made a motion that the request be denied.

Mr Boykin seconded the motion.

Ms Sullivan, Mr Boykin and Mr Smith voted in favor of the motion.

Mr Holladay and Mr Beall abstained from voting.

Request - Water:

Mayor Edgar read a request from Vamous Culpepper to be connected to the water system.

Superintendent Franklin Davenport stated that there is a line in place to which Mr Culpepper's residence can be connected.

Mr Smith made a motion that Mr Cuipepper be allowed to connect to the water system.

Ms Sullivan seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous.

Clerk's Office:

Mr Beall made a motion to take bids to enclose the Clerk's office.

Ms Sullivan seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous.

Zoning - Building Inspector and Judge Contract:

Ms Sullivan reported to the Council that she had attended the County Commissioners meeting and it has been agreed to continue with the contract for the use of John Champion, Harris County Building Inspector and Judge William Burton Steis for the enforcement of zoning during the year of 1990.

Noise Ordinance:

Mr Boykin presented a noise ordinance for the first reading.

Mixed Drink Referendum:

Mr Boykin made a motion to call for a mixed drink and package sales referendum on the March ballot.

Ms Sullivan seconded the motion.

Mr Boykin, Ms Sullivan, Mr Beall and Mr Holladay voted in favor of the motion.

Mr Smith abstained from voting.

Chlorinator - Sewerage Treatment Plant:

Mr Davenport stated to the Council that the chlorinator at the treatment plant must be replaced. Mr Davenport would like to buy a chlorinator which uses appreciably less water than the one currently in use.

Ms Sullivan made a motion that Mr Davenport purchase the new chlorinator.

Mr Holladay seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous.

Police Department - Tires:

Chief of Police Carl David White explained to the Council that Sergeant Shaw's personal vehicle had been sabotaged by the puncture of the tires with carpet tacks. The cost of new tires is \$315.00.

Ms Sullivan made a motion to pay for the tires.

Mr Boykin seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous.

Police Department:

Chief White stated that there are three trees at the police station which are dangerous and need to be removed.

Superintendent of Elections:

Ms Sullivan made a motion that Barbara Ewell be appointed 1990 Superintendent of Elections.

Mr Boykin seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous.

Beer and Wine Application:

Mayor Edgar read an application from Raymond "Sandy" Reames, Jr for the second month.

Mr Holladay made a motion that the application be approved.
Mr Boykin seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous.

Upon motion by Mr Boykin, seconded by Mr Holladay and agreed upon by
all, the meeting was adjourned.
