

Acts of the Council - July 9, 1990

The City Council of the Town of Pine Mountain met in regular session on the evening of July 9, 1990 at seven o'clock P. M. in the City Hall.

Mayor James V. Edgar presided with Councilpersons J. R. Beall, Franklin D. Boykin, P. C. Holladay, Vance C. Smith and Patricia E. Sullivan in attendance.

Minutes - June 11, 1990:

Upon motion by Mr. Holladay, seconded by Mr. Beall and agreed to by all, the minutes of the June 11, 1990 meeting were approved as written.

Annexation Petition:

Mr. James Robert Black appeared before the Council and read a petition requesting annexation on behalf of Ida Cason Callaway Foundation, Callaway Gardens Resort, Inc. and Davis Inn. The area specified in the petition is comprised of 1,151.77.

Ordinances - First Reading:

Mayor Edgar presented the following ordinances for the first reading:

1. An Ordinance to Amend Charter.
2. An Ordinance to Annex Certain Land into the Town.
3. An Ordinance Establishing Service Districts.
4. An Ordinance to Approve the Execution of a City Contract

The second reading of these ordinances will take place at the regular City Council meeting to be held August 13, 1990.

Ordinance for Regulating Sale of Alcoholic Beverages by the Drink and for Consumption on Premises:

Mr. Holladay made a motion that the Ordinance above mentioned by approved and adopted. Ms. Sullivan seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous.

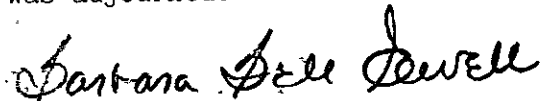
Budget - New Employees:

Mayor Edgar mentioned to the Council that two new positions had been budgeted for FY 90/91. It was decided by the Council to advertise these jobs.

Georgia Department of Community Affairs - Local Development Fund:

Mayor Edgar announced to the Council that Pine Mountain had been selected as a recipient of a Local Development Grant in the amount of \$8,450.00. This grant shall be used to assist Pine Mountain in the construction of 864 linear feet of a 4-foot wide concrete sidewalk along the state R-O-W along Georgia Highway 18 from Wood Avenue to the city limits.
