

ACTS OF THE COUNCIL

March 12, 1990

The Town Council of the Town of Pine Mountain sat in regular session on the evening of March 12, 1990 at seven o'clock P. M. in the Town Hall.

Mayor James V Edgar presided with Councilpersons J Richard Beall, Franklin D Boykin, P C Holladay, Vance C Smith and Patricia E Sullivan in attendance.

AUDIT F/Y 88/89:

Mrs Susan Johnson and Mr Spier Burdette of J K Boatwright and Company appeared before the Council to present the FY 88/89 audit of the Town of Pine Mountain financial records.

NOISE ORDINANCE:

Mr Boykin gave the second reading of a proposed noise ordinance.  
Mr Boykin made a motion to adopt the ordinance.  
Ms Sullivan seconded the motion.  
There was a discussion of various points of the proposed ordinance.  
Mr Boykin voted in favor of the motion.  
Mr Holladay, Ms Sullivan and Mr Smith voted in opposition to the motion.  
Mr Beall abstained from voting.  
Mayor Edgar appointed Mr Boykin, Mr Beall and Chief of Police David White to a committee for the formulation of a new ordinance.

WHOLE HARMLESS AGREEMENT:

Mayor Edgar explained to the Council that in order to move the sewerage project more quickly, a whole harmless agreement could be executed by the Council which would eliminate several time consuming steps.  
Mr Holladay made a motion to sign the agreement.  
Ms Sullivan seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous.

CITIZEN COMPLAINT:

Mr William Hogg, Mrs Bonnie Dorsey, Mr Bruce Dorsey and Mr Charlie Henry Fannin appeared before the Council to register various complaints about the pallet business in the building owned by Mr Charles Culp on Georgia Street.  
Mayor Edgar asked that Mrs Ewell contact the Harris County Building Inspector, Mr John Champion, about the matter.

ADJOURNMENT:

Upon motion by Mr Holladay, seconded by Ms Sullivan and voted favorably upon by all, the meeting was adjourned.
