

ACTS OF THE COUNCIL
October 8, 1990

The Town Council of the Town of Pine Mountain met in regular session on the evening of October 8, 1990 at seven o'clock P M in the Town Hall.

Mayor James V Edgar presided with Councilpersons J R Beall, Franklin D Boykin, P C Holladay, Vance C Smith and Patricia E Sullivan in attendance.

Minutes - September 10, 1990 and September 20, 1990:

Upon motion by Mr Holladay, seconded by Ms Sullivan and agreed upon by all, the minutes of the September 10 and September 20, 1990 meetings were approved as written.

Joe Manning:

Mr Joe Manning appeared before the Council to make certain inquiries about the recent annexation and the tax status of the annexed properties.

Mr J Ronald Mullins, City Attorney, responded by explaining the Special Tax District.

Pine Mountain Tourism Association:

Ms Judy Russell of the Pine Mountain Tourism Association appeared before the Council to present an agreement and a contract to be acted upon by the Council for the distribution of the Hotel/Motel Tax receipts.

After lengthy discussion, it was agreed that the documents should be re-written and presented for action at a later date.

Ida Cason Callaway Foundation:

Ms Russell also appeared on behalf of the Ida Cason Callaway Foundation to present an agreement to move forward under House Bill 770.

It was agreed to table the agreement until an agreement with the Pine Mountain Tourism Association has been reached.

Applications - Alcohol, Beer and Wine:

Mayor Edgar presented an application made by Callaway Gardens Resort, Inc. for the sale of alcoholic beverages, beer and wine for the second reading.

Ms Sullivan made a motion to approve the application.

Mr Holladay seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous.

3% Hotel/Motel Tax:

Mayor Edgar presented the 3% Hotel/Motel Tax Ordinance for the second reading.

Mr Holladay made a motion that the ordinance be adopted.

Mr Smith seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous.

Application for Annexation:

Mayor Edgar presented for the first reading an application made by Carol Bowman of TCB Enterprises, Inc for 100% annexation of her home and motel.

Noise Ordinance:

Mr Boykin presented a noise ordinance for the first reading.

Dumpster:

Mr Holladay made a motion to give the dumpster presently in the alley behind Kimbrough's General Store to Mr Kimbrough. Mr Kimbrough will repair and maintain the dumpster.

Ms Sullivan seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous.

Upon motion by Mr Boykin, seconded by Mr Holladay and agreed upon by all, the meeting was adjourned.
