

ACTS OF THE COUNCIL

December 9, 1991

The City Council of the Town of Pine Mountain met in regular session on the evening of December 9, 1991 in the Town Hall at seven o'clock P. M.

Mayor James V. Edgar presided with Councilpersons J. Richard Beall, Franklin D. Boykin, P. C. Holladay and Patricia E. Sullivan in attendance.

Minutes - November 11 and December 3, 1991:

Upon motion by Ms. Sullivan, seconded by Mr. Holladay and agreed upon by all, the minutes of the November 11 and December 3, 1991 meetings were approved as written.

Annexation - Boyd Boys, Inc. - Second Reading:

Mayor Edgar presented an application for annexation form Boyd Boys, Inc. for the second reading.

Mr. Holladay made a motion to accept and approve the application to become effective January 1, 1992.

Mr. Beall seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous.

Ordinance for Establishing Building Permits, Electrical Permit, Plumbing Permit, Mechanical Permit, Gas Permit and Reinspection Fee:

Mayor Edgar presented the said ordinance for the first reading.

Zoning Ordinance - Addendum:

Mayor Edgar presented the additions to the zoning ordinance for the first reading.

Water and Sewer Ordinance - Second Reading:

Mayor Edgar presented the water and sewer ordinance for the second reading.

After some discussion, Mayor Edgar appointed Councilmen Beall and Boykin as a committee to draft an ordinance which will be in line with the wishes of the Council.

Area Agency on Aging - Mrs. Meg Bradley:

Mrs. Meg Bradley appeared before the Council to ask the support of the Council for the Area Agency on Aging programs during FY 92/93.

Mr. Holladay made a motion that the Town of Pine Mountain contribute six hundred dollars (\$600.00).

Ms. Sullivan seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous.

Property Tax:

Mr. Holladay made a motion to extend the property tax due date until January 15, 1992.

Mr. Boykin seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous.

Cemetery Option - Mr. Charlie Rowe:

Ms. Sullivan made a motion to grant Mr. Charlie Rowe an option on an additional two half lots. The total amount will now be six hundred dollars plus sixty dollars option fee.

Mr. Holladay seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous.

First United Methodist Church:

Mayor Edgar presented a letter from the Pine Mountain First United Methodist Church requesting permission to connect to the sewer line near the Pine Mountain Police Department.

Mr. Holladay made a motion to permit the line to be connected to the sewer line in that location and require that the line be deeded to the town.

Mr. Boykin seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous.

Recycling:

Mr. Holladay gave a report to the Council concerning recycling and the results of his contacts with other cities which are in the process of recycling.

Dumpster:

Mr. Franklin Davenport, General Superintendent, reported to the Council that the dumpster the Council gave to Kimbrough General Store is in such poor condition it cannot be emptied without the contents falling out and scattering on the ground.

Ms. Sullivan made a motion that the town notify Kimbrough's that if the dumpster is not repaired within thirty days, so that the employees of the town can handle it safely, the dumpster will be removed.

Business License Ordinance:

Mr. Boykin made a motion that the 1991 Business License Ordinance be adopted as the 1992 Business License Ordinance.

Mr. Holladay seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous.

Upon motion by Mr. Holladay, seconded by Mr. Beall and agreed upon by all, the meeting was adjourned.
