

ACTS OF THE COUNCIL
February 11, 1991

The Town Council of the Town of Pine Mountain met in regular session on the evening of February 11, 1991 at seven o'clock P M in the Town Hall.

Mayor James V Edgar presided with Councilpersons J R Beall, Franklin D Boykin, P C Holladay, Vance C Smith and Patricia E Sullivan in attendance.

Utility Service Company - Mr Jeff Shelton:

Mr Jeff Shelton of Utility Service Company appeared before the Council to present the results of an inspection of water tank # 1. Mr Shelton reported that inside the tank there is a 30-40% loss of coating which will cause a loss of metal. The outside of the tank has surface oxidation affecting 15% of the tank.

Mr Shelton presented three options for consideration.

Option 1: Do nothing.

Option 2: Renovate the tank at the minimum cost of \$22,237.00.

Option 3: Renovate the tank and contract for a maintenance program.

For this option the fee shall be as follows:

Year 1-3: \$9,075.00

Year 4+ \$4,200.00

Kings Gap Road - Name Change:

Mayor Edgar reported to the Council that Mr George Elmore, Chairman of the Harris County Board of Commissioners, has received complaints from citizens on Kings Gap Road stating the name of the street is confused with that of State Park Road (formerly Kings Gap Road) and it is difficult to give or follow directions.

Ms Sullivan made a motion to change Kings Gap Road to Davis Lake Road.

Mr Smith seconded the motion.

Ms Sullivan, Mr Smith, Mr Holladay and Mr Boykin voted in favor of the motion.

Mr Beall abstained from voting.

Water Request - Mr Don Roberts:

Mr Don Roberts appeared before the Council to request water service at his new driving range on Georgia Highway One North.

Mr Holladay made a motion that water service be granted to Mr Roberts.

Mr Smith seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous.

GMA - Census:

Mayor Edgar reported that the Georgia Municipal Association is in the process of determining how many Georgia municipalities are interested in taking part in an Intervention in Census Lawsuit. Participation cost would be determined on a per capita basis.

Mr Holladay made a motion that GMA be notified that Pine Mountain is interested, but does not wish to be committed at the present time.

Mr Smith seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous.

Distilled Spirits License - Callaway Gardens Resort, Inc.:

Mayor Edgar presented the first reading of an application from Callaway Gardens Resort, Inc. for a Distilled Spirits License for Mountain View Food Concession.

Pine Mountain Tax Collector:

Ms Sullivan made a motion that Barbara Ewell be appointed tax collector for Pine Mountain.

Mr Holladay seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous.

Pine Mountain Tourism Association:

Mrs Kim Ambrester of the Pine Mountain Tourism Association appeared before the Council to report on projects in progress.

Pine Mountain Slogan:

Ms Sullivan made a motion that the contest for a Pine Mountain slogan be opened immediately and closed April 1, 1991. Notice of the contest is to be placed in the Harris County Journal and on the water bills. The contest is to be open only to Pine Mountain citizens. The judges shall be Mr Michael Bishop, Mrs Josephine Bray and Mr Jimmy Mitchum. Mr Boykin seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous.

Upon motion by Mr Holladay, seconded by Ms Sullivan and agreed upon by all, the meeting was adjourned.
