

Acts of the Council
January 14, 1991

The City Council of the Town of Pine Mountain met in regular session on the evening of January 14, 1991 at seven o'clock P. M. in the Town Hall.

Mayor James V. Edgar presided with Councilpersons J. R. Beall, Franklin D. Boykin, P. C. Holladay, Vance C. Smith and Patricia E. Sullivan in attendance.

Minutes - December 10, 1990 and January 2, 1991:

Upon motion by Ms. Sullivan, seconded by Mr. Holladay and agreed upon by all, the minutes of the December 10, 1990 and January 2, 1991 meetings were approved as written.

Audit FY 89/90:

Mrs. Susan Johnson of J. K. Boatwright and Co. P. C. appeared before the Council to present the FY 89/90 audit.

Property Taxes:

Upon motion by Ms. Sullivan, seconded by Mr. Beall and agreed upon by all, the following property tax accounts were designated as uncollectable and will no longer be accounts receivable.

Area Agency on Aging - Meg Bradley:

Mrs. Bradley appeared before the Council to ask that the Town of Pine Mountain consider funding meals for one or two elderly citizens during FY 91/92.

Mr. Holladay made a motion to budget \$1,000.00 to supply meals at the Senior Center for two Pine Mountain senior citizens.

Ms. Sullivan seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous.

Business License - Arts and Crafts Fair:

Ms. Sullivan made a motion that a business license for arts and crafts fairs be ten dollars (\$10.00) per booth.

Mr. Boykin seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous.

Hotel/Motel Tax Form:

Mr. Holladay made a motion to ammend the Hotel/Motel Tax Ordinance to include a form for reporting purposes.

Mr. Beall seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous.

Road Race:

Mayor Edgar presented a request from Mr. Lon Marlowe requesting permission to hold a road race in Pine Mountain.

Ms. Sullivan made a motion to approve the request if Chief of Police Carl David White agrees to the plans.

Mr. Smith seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous.

City Elections:

Mayor Edgar announced to the Council that elections for three City Council seats will be held March 20, 1991.

Qualifying dates for the election shall be January 28, 1991 - February 26, 1991. Qualifying fee shall be \$10.80.

The deadline for voter registration shall be March 5, 1991.

The election manager shall be Barbara Ewell.

Pine Mountain Tourism Association:

Mayor Edgar appointed Councilman J. R. Beall as the Council representative to the Pine Mountain Tourism Association.

Mr. Henry A. Mullins:

Mr. Mullins appeared before the Council to suggest that the Mayor and Council sponsor a Pine Mountain slogan contest.

Mayor Edgar stated that several matters will be investigated and the subject will be discussed again at a later date.
