

Acts of The Council
July 8, 1991

The City Council of the Town of Pine Mountain met in regular session on the evening of July 8, 1991 in the Town Hall at seven o'clock P. M.

Mayor James V. Edgar presided with Councilpersons J. R. Beall, Franklin D. Boykin, P. C. Holladay and Vance C. Smith in attendance.

Minutes - June 10, 1991:

Upon motion by Mr. Holladay, seconded by Mr. Boykin and agreed upon by all, the minutes of the Budget Hearing and City Council Meeting of June 10, 1991 were approved as written.

Pine Mountain Tourism Association:

Mrs. Kim Ambruster of the Pine Mountain Tourism Association appeared before the Council to present the budget for FY 91/92. Mr. Holladay made a motion to renew the current contract for the period of one more year.

Mr. Smith seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous.

Water Service:

Mr. Holladay made a motion to connect the current water lines to those of CGRI with an eight inch line at the cost of \$7,726.60.

Mr. Smith seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous.

Beer and Wine Application - Second Reading:

Mayor Edgar presented the application of Ms. Martha Sledge for the second reading.

Mr. Holladay made a motion that the application be approved.

Mr. Boykin seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous.

Sewer Service:

Mr. W. Kendrick Askew appeared before the Council to request assistance in running lines to connect Mr. John Oxford to the sewer system.

The matter was tabled.

Mr. Harry Boyd appeared before the Council to present a plat and plans for connecting Chipley Village to the sewer system, the line to be run at the expense of Mr. Boyd.

Mr. Smith made a motion that Mr. Boyd be allowed to run a line and connect to the system at the intersection of Sullivan Circle and Malida Creek Terrace. The line is to be deeded to the Town.

Mr. Beall seconded the motion and the Vote was unanimous.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned.
