

ACTS OF THE COUNCIL

June 10, 1991

The City Council of the Town of Pine Mountain met in regular session on the evening of June 10, 1991 in the Town Hall.

Mayor James V. Edgar presided with Councilpersons J. R. Beall, Franklin D. Boykin, P. C. Holladay, Vance C. Smith and Patricia E. Sullivan in attendance.

Minutes - May 13, 1991:

Mr. Beall made a motion that the minutes of May 13, 1991 be approved as written.

Mr. Smith seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous.

Lower Chattahoochee Area Planning and Development Commission:

Mrs. Tracey Sammons of the LCAPDC appeared before the Council to ask that the Town of Pine Mountain appoint two citizens to serve on a joint planning committee to formulate the Comprehensive Plan required by the Georgia Department of Community Affairs.

Ms. Sullivan made a motion to appoint Mr. H. A. Mullins and Mr. Bobby Johnston to the committee.

Mr. Holladay seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous.

Mrs. Sammons also presented a cooperative joint-planning agreement between Harris County, Pine Mountain, Shiloh and Waverly Hall stating that they shall jointly submit for review their Comprehensive Plan and Harris County shall be authorized to act as lead agency.

Mr. Holladay made a motion that the agreement be signed.

Ms. Sullivan seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous.

Pine Mountain Tourism Association:

Mrs. Kim Ambrester appeared before the Council to present a progress report.

Mr. Don Taylor appeared before the Council to present plans for a Christmas festival. Mr. Taylor asked the Council's permission to implement the plans.

The Council asked Mr. Taylor to clear up a few points and re-submit the plans.

Beer and Wine Application:

The application from Ms. Martha Sledge for the retail of beer and wine was tabled since the fingerprint records had not been received.

Comprehensive Maintenance Program Resolution:

A Compliance Maintenance Program Resolution required by the Georgia Department of Natural Resources - Environmental Protection Division - was presented by Mayor Edgar.

Mr. Holladay made a motion that the resolution be signed.

Mr. Smith seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous.

Request for Exemption from Sewerage Fees:

Mayor Edgar read a letter from Mr. Steven H. DeHaan requisition that he not be charged for sewerage on 4,380 gallons of water he used to fill his swimming pool.

Mr. Boykin made a motion to deny the request.

Mr. Holladay seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous.

Sign - Police Department:

Ms. Sullivan made a motion that a sand-blasted sign be purchased for the front of the Police Department.

Mr. Boykin seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous.

Budget - FY 91/92:

Mayor Edgar presented the proposed budgets for FY 91/92.

Ms. Sullivan made a motion to adopt the proposed budgets.

Mr. Holladay seconded the motion.

Ms. Sullivan , Mr. Holladay, Mr. Beall and Mr. Smith voted in favor of the motion.

Mr. Boykin voted in opposition to the motion.

Elected Officials Dinner:

Mayor Edgar announced that Harris County will host an Elected Officials Dinner at Mountaintop Restaurant on June 27, 1991 at seven o'clock P. M.

Mr. Holladay made a motion to participate.

Ms. Sullivan seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned.
