

Acts of the Council
May 11, 1992

The City Council of the Town of Pine Mountain sat in regular session on the evening of Monday, May 11, 1992 at seven o'clock P. M. in the Town Hall.

Mayor James V. Edgar presided with Councilpersons J Richard Beall, Franklin D Boykin and Vance C Smith, Sr. in attendance.

Minutes - April 13:

Upon motion by Mr Beall, seconded by Mr Boykin and agreed upon by all, the minutes of the April 13, 1992 meeting were approved as written.

Pine Mountain Tourism Association:

Mr Jack Dresher of the Pine Mountain Tourism Association appeared before the Council to report on April activities and to announce that there will be a seminar on Thursday, May 14th at the Chipley Womans' Club.

Annexation - Springdale Farms:

Mayor gave the first reading of an application for annexation by Mr Frank Heard on behalf of Springdale Farms.
The Council asked that Mr Davenport and Mr Smith inspect the streets in the subdivision.

Water and Sewer Ordinance - Second Reading:

Mr Boykin made a motion to adopt the water and sewer ordinance to become effective July 1, 1992.
Mr Smith seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous.

Application - Retail Sales of Beer and Wine - CGRI- Second Reading:

Mayor read an application from Callaway Gardens Resort for a retail beer and wine license for the second time.
Mr Smith made a motion that the license be granted.
Mr Beall seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous.

Master Meters - Pine Lane and Pine Village Apartments:

Mayor Edgar explained to the Council that when an agreement was made to individually meter the apartments, the owner agreed to pay all amounts which were left owing when a customer moved. The owner has failed to comply with the agreement.
Mr Boykin made a motion that all apartments be billed to the management firm handling the apartments.
Mr Smith seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned.
