

Acts of the Council - May 13, 1991

The City Council of the Town of Pine Mountain met in regular session on the evening of May 13, 1991, at seven o'clock P. M. in the City Hall.

Mayor James V. Edgar presided with Councilmen J. R. Beall, Franklin D. Boykin and Vance C. Smith in attendance.

Acts of the Council - April 8, 1991:

Upon motion by Mr. Boykin, seconded by Mr. Smith and agreed upon by all, the minutes of the April 8, 1991 meeting were approved as written.

Water Tank:

Mr. Casey Thompson of Thompson Enterprises appeared before the Council to present an analysis of water tank # 1 and a plan for repairs and painting.

Beer and Wine Application:

Mayor Edgar read an application from Ms. Martha Sledge requesting a license to retail beer and wine at Moneyback Food Store. The application will be read the second time at the June meeting.

Slogan Contest:

Mayor Edgar announced that the winning slogan for the Town of Pine Mountain was "Nature's Headquarters".

Mr. Beall made a motion that a prize of fifty dollars (\$50.00) be awarded to the winner.

Mr. Boykin seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous.

The winning entry was submitted by Joey Samples.

Water and Sewer Request:

Mayor Edgar read a request from Mr. Al Boyd and Mr. Harry Boyd for water and sewer hook-ups to the block of shops and storage facilities now under construction.

Mr. Boykin made a motion to grant the request for water service.

Mr. Smith seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous.

Mr. Boykin made a motion to require plans to be submitted for a connection to the sewer system.

Mr. Beall seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous.

Celebrate Freedom:

TV 33 will run rebroadcasts of the Celebrate Freedom program on May 27th and again on May 30th. Sponsorship of the program will cost \$25.00.

Mr. Smith made a motion that the Town of Pine Mountain agree to become a sponsor.

Mr. Beall seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous.

Upon motion by Mr. Smith, seconded by Mr. Boykin and agreed upon by all, the meeting was adjourned.
