

Acts of the Council  
November 11, 1991

The City Council of the Town of Pine Mountain sat in regular session on the evening of November 11, 1991 at seven o'clock P. M. in the City Hall.

Mayor Pro Tem Vance C. Smith presided with Councilpersons J. R. Beall, Franklin D. Boykin, P. C. Holladay and Patricia E. Sullivan in attendance.

Minutes - September 9, 1991:

Upon motion by Ms. Sullivan, seconded by Mr. Holladay and approved by all, the minutes of the September 9, 1991 meeting were approved as written.

Pine Mountain Tourism Association:

Ms. Carol Bowman, President of the Pine Mountain Tourism Association appeared before the Council to present a report of the activities of the Association.

Annexation:

Mr. Harry Boyd appeared before the Council to present a request for annexation. The request was read for the first time.

Don Taylor:

Mr. Don Taylor appeared before the Council to request a donation be given to assist with the Christmas decorations for the downtown area. Ms. Sullivan made a motion to tell Mrs. Jarvis Shepherd that she must present parade plans and get a permit to hold a Christmas parade. Mr. Boykin seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous. Ms. Sullivan made a motion to donate \$1,500.00 to the Pine Mountain Tourism Association to be used to purchase Christmas decorations. Mr. Holladay seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous.

Resolution - To Adopt State Code:

Mr. Smith presented a Resolution authorizing enforcement of mandatory statewide construction codes. Ms. Sullivan made a motion that the Resolution be adopted. Mr. Holladay seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous.

Ordinance to Establish Building Permits:

Mr. Smith presented an Ordinance for Establishing Building Permit, Electrical Permit, Plumbing Permit, Mechanical Permit, Gas Permit and Reinspection Fees for the first reading. The matter was tabled.

Zoning Ordinance Amendment:

Mr. Smith presented an amendment to the Zoning ordinance.

The matter was tabled.

Water and Sewerage Ordinance - Second Reading:

Mr. Smith presented the Water and Sewer Ordinance for the second reading.

The matter was tabled.

Christmas Dinner:

Mr. Smith announced that the Christmas dinner for the employees will be held December 13th at the Conference Center dining room at Callaway Gardens.

Pine Mountain Volunteer Fire Department:

Mr. Franklin Davenport, Fire Chief, announced to the Council that the new volunteer firemen will be tested soon and refreshments will be served at the Pine Mountain Police Department on the night of the next Council meeting.

Upon a motion by Mr. Holladay, seconded by Mr. Boykin and agreed upon by all, the meeting was adjourned.
