

ACTS OF THE COUNCIL

August 10, 1992

The City Council of the Town of Pine Mountain met in regular session on the evening of August 10, 1992 at seven o'clock P. M. in the Town Hall.

Mayor James V Edgar presided with Councilpersons J Richard Beall, Franklin D Boykin, P C Holladay, Vance C Smith and Patricia E Sullivan in attendance.

Pine Mountain Tourism Association:

Mr. Jack Dresher of the Pine Mountain Tourism Association appeared before the Council to present an update on the Heritage Festival to be held October 31 and November 1, 1992.

Lower Chattahoochee Area Planning and Development Commission:

Ms. Traci Hearne of the Lower Chattahoochee APDC appeared before the Council to present a draft of the sub-division ordinance and the completed Comprehensive Plan.

First Baptist Church:

Mr. Ken Askew, Chairman of the Housing Committee of the First Baptist Church, appeared to ask permission to cut three trees in order to move the Murray house, which has been sold by the church and will be moved to a new site.

Mr. Holladay made a motion to give the church permission to cut the trees.

Ms. Sullivan seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous.

Springdale Farms:

Mr. Hugh Riley appeared before the Council to present a revised plat of the sub-division.

Street Abandonment:

J Ronald Mullins, Jr., City Attorney appeared before the Council to explain his research on street abandonment. The Town cannot sell town property for private benefit. The options are to either lease the unopened street or abandon the street and give the adjoining owner the opportunity to purchase the property. The unopened street may be sold by sealed bids if the adjoining owners do not wish to purchase the property.

Callaway Gardens Resort, Inc.:

Mr. Boykin made a motion to permit beverage sales at Mountainview Clubhouse on a one time only basis on Sunday, October 4, 1992.

Ms. Sullivan seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous.

Bids - Police Car:

Mayor Edgar opened the bids which have been received for the sale of the police car, which were as follows:

Mr. Boykin made a motion to accept Mr. Tumlin's bid of \$525.00.

Mr. Holladay seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous.

Municipal Court:

Ms. Sullivan made a motion to pay officers and the clerk \$25.00 for each monthly appearance in Municipal Court.

Mr. Boykin seconded the motion.

Ms. Sullivan, Mr. Boykin, Mr. Holladay and Mr. Smith voted in favor of the motion.

Mr. Beall abstained from voting.

Recycling:

Mr. Holladay gave a report on a trip he and Mayor Edgar took to visit the recycling center in LaGrange.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned.
