

Acts of the Council
February 10, 1992

The City Council of the Town of Pine Mountain met in regular session on the evening of February 10, 1992 at seven o'clock P. M. in the Town Hall.

Mayor James V. Edgar presided with Councilpersons J. R. Beall, Franklin D. Boykin, P. C. Holladay, Vance C. Smith and Patricia E. Sullivan in attendance.

Minutes - January 13, 1992:

Upon Motion by Ms. Sullivan, seconded by Mr. Holladay and approved by all, the minutes of the January 13, 1992 meeting were approved as written.

Water and Sewerage Ordinance:

Mr. Beall presented two proposals for the Council to consider, each of which would collect the funds needed to meet the obligations of the utility company.

Gardenview Drive:

Mr. Franklin Davenport, General Superintendent, explained to the Council that there is a water run-off problem on the southern portion of Gardenview Drive which can be alleviated by a layer of crushed stone. The cost of the stone would be approximately eight hundred dollars (\$800.00).

Ms. Sullivan made a motion to gravel the street.

Mr. Holladay seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous.

Pine Mountain Tourism Association:

Ms. Carol Bowman of the Pine Mountain Tourism Association appeared before the Council to briefly report on the search for a new director.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned.
