

CITY COUNCIL MEETING

July 13, 1992

The City Council of the Town sat in regular session on the evening of June 13, 1992 at seven o'clock P.M. in the Town Hall.

Mayor James V. Edgar presided with Councilpersons J R Beall, Franklin D. Boykin, P C Holladay, Vance C Smith and Patricia E Sullivan in attendance.

MINUTES:

Upon motion by Ms. Sullivan, seconded by Mr. Holladay and agreed upon by all, the minutes of the June 8th and June 28th were approved as written.

PINE MOUNTAIN TOURISM ASSOCIATION:

Mr. Jack Drescher of the Pine Mountain Tourism Association appeared before the Council to present the 1992/1993 contract and the 92/93 budget.

Mr. Drescher also announced that the PMTA will donate \$10,000.00 to the Town to use toward beautification.

LOWER CHATTAHOOCHEE AREA PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT COMMISSION

Ms. Patti Parker of the Lower Chattahoochee APDC appeared before the Council to present the final draft of the Comprehensive Plan.

Mr. Holladay made a motion to adopt the plan as presented.

Mr. Beall seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous.

BIDS - POLICE CAR:

Ms. Sullivan made a motion to authorize the City Clerk to advertise for bids for the sale of a 1984 Ford LDT police car.

Mr. Smith seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous.

SANITATION:

Mr. Boykin made a motion that the following sanitation rates be charged to the merchants who have dumpster containers.

Forty dollars (\$40.00) per month for one container to include two pick-ups per month.

Each additional pick-up to cost five dollars (\$5.00).

Mr. Holladay seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous.

BUDGET:

Mr. Holladay made a motion to reduce the FY/92-93 beautification budget by the amount of \$10,000.00 thereby reducing the General Funds FY92-93 budget to \$362,529.00

Mr. Boykin seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous.

Upon motion by Mr. Holladay, seconded by Mr. Boykin and agreed upon by all, the meeting was adjourned.
