

CITY COUNCIL MEETING
June 8, 1992

The City Council met in regular session on the evening of June 8, 1992 in the City Hall at seven o'clock P. M.

Mayor James V Edgar presided with Councilpersons J. Richard Beall, Franklin D. Boykin, P. C. Holladay, Vance C. Smith and Patricia E. Sullivan in attendance.

Minutes:

Upon motion by Ms Sullivan, seconded by Mr Holladay and agreed upon by all, the minutes of the May 11th City Council meeting and May 27th zoning hearing were approved as written.

Pine Mountain Tourism Association:

Mr. Scott Anderson, president of the Pine Mountain Tourism Association, appeared before the Council to present a letter requesting the Council to appoint some members of the community to serve on a committee to be formed for the purpose of a study of State and Federal grants to use in an effort to develop Pine Mountain.

Mr Beall made a motion that such a committee be appointed.

Ms Sullivan seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous.

Mayor Edgar appointed Mr Beall to represent the Council on the Committee.

Mr Anderson also asked that a special meeting be held in late June for the Pine Mountain Tourism Association to request an extension of the contract.

Mayor Edgar set the date of the meeting for June 23rd at six o'clock P. M.

Springdale Farms - Annexation:

Mr Holladay made a motion to approve the annexation of the Springdale Farms sub-division with the provision that the streets and water lines are dedicated to the Town of Pine Mountain.

Ms Sullivan seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous.

Pine Valley Cable:

Mr Williams appeared before the Council to request that the ordinance preparation be accelerated.

The businesses of Krispy Fried Chicken, The Garden Cottage, Pine Mountain Beverage Mart, Southern Pines Restaurant and Deli, Piccolo's and J. & J. Outdoors will pay all expenses involved in the hook-up.

Funding Search:

Mr Holladay made a motion to pay Precision Planning, Inc five hundred dollars (\$500.00) to write applications in the effort to search for funding for beautification.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned.
