

ACTS OF THE COUNCIL

March 9, 1992

The City Council of the Town of Pine Mountain met in regular session on the evening of March 9, 1992, at seven o'clock P. M. in the Town Hall.

Mayor James V Edgar presided with Councilpersons J. R. Beall, Franklin D. Boykin, Vance C. Smith and Patricia E. Sullivan in attendance.

Minutes - February 10, 1992:

Upon motion by Ms. Sullivan, seconded by Mr. Smith and unanimously agreed upon, the minutes of the February 10, 1992 meeting were approved as written.

Pine Mountain Tourism Association:

Ms. Carol Bowman, president of the Pine Mountain Tourism Association, appeared before the Council to introduce Mr. Jack Dresher, the newly appointed director.

Water and Sewerage Ordinance:

Mr. Beall stated that he has some adjustments to make in the previous proposals and the new proposal will be presented at a later date.

Roofing Bids:

Mayor Edgar announced that only one bid for the repair of the roofs at the City Hall and the Police Station had been received.

The bid from B & A Roofing Company was as follows:

Mr. Boykin made a motion to reject the bid and call for new bids.

Ms. Sullivan seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous.

Pawn Shop License Fee:

Mayor Edgar asked the Council to set a license fee for the operation of a pawn shop.

Ms. Sullivan made a motion that the business license fee be set at four hundred dollars (\$400.00).

Mr. Smith seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous.

Boykin Lease:

Mayor Edgar presented the revised lease agreement between the Town of Pine Mountain and Franklin D. and Charlotte Boykin. Mayor Edgar stated that the present wording meets with the approval of City Attorney Ronald Mullins. Mr. Mullins did however, wish to understand why only one parcel is mentioned in this lease. Mr. Boykin stated that the others will be presented later.

Ms. Sullivan made a motion to sign the lease agreement.

Mr. Smith seconded the motion.

Ms. Sullivan, Mr. Smith, and Mr. Beall voted in favor of the motion.

Mr. Boykin abstained from voting.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned.
