

CITY COUNCIL MEETING

October 12, 1992

The City Council met in regular session on the evening of October 12, 1992 at 7 o'clock P. M. in the City Hall.

Mayor Pro-Tem Vance C Smith presided with Councilpersons J Richard Beall, Franklin D Boykin and Patricia E Sullivan in attendance.

Minutes - September Meeting:

Upon motion by Ms. Sullivan, seconded by Mr. Beall and unanimously voted upon the minutes were approved as written with typographical corrections.

W. Kendrick Askew:

Mr. Askew appeared before the Council to inquire as to the reasons for the objections to a motel on the property which was not rezoned.

Norsouth Corporation:

Ms. Paula Potter appeared before the Council to address the water metering at Pine Lane and Pine Village Apartments.

Ms. Sullivan made a motion to bill each individually metered apartment and to authorize the city attorney to work out an agreement with Norsouth and their attorney.

Ms. Sullivan further moved to bill a deposit of \$30.00 to those tenants who lived in the apartments before July 1, 1992 a thirty dollar deposit and those who moved in after July 1, 1992 a fifty dollar deposit.

Mr. Boykin seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous.

Mr. Beall made a motion to forgive the penalties on the tenants bills due to the confusion of the issue.

Ms. Sullivan seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned.
