

ACTS OF THE COUNCIL
September 14, 1992

The Town Council of the Town of Pine Mountain met in regular session on the evening of September 14, 1992 at seven o'clock P. M. in the town hall.

Mayor James V Edgar presided with Councilpersons J Richard Beall, P C Holladay and Patricia E Sullivan in attendance.

Reverend John Beyers of the Pine Mountain First United Methodist Church opened the meeting with prayer.

Minutes of August 10, 1992:

Upon motion by Ms Sullivan, seconded by Mr Holladay and unanimously agreed to by all the minutes of the August 10, 1992 meeting were approved as read.

Pine Mountain Tourism Association:

Mr Jack Dresher of the PMTA appeared before the Council to present the FY 91/92 audit.

Mr Dresher also reported that the Heritage Festival plans are well under way. There will be a three hour live remote radio broadcast for the festival on October 31st as well as various radio spots during the three weeks preceding the festival. Mr Dresher requested that the Town assist with the cost of the advertisements.

Mr. Holladay made a motion that the Town donate \$250.00 toward advertisements for the festival.

Mr Beall seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous.

Mr Beall made a motion that a resolution be signed in support of the Heritage Festival.

Mr Holladay seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous.

Water Tank - Bid Opening:

The Town of Pine Mountain advertised for bids on the water tank and three bids were received. The Mayor opened the sealed bids and they were as follows:

Ms Sullivan seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous.

Pine Lane - Pine Village Apartments - Water:

Mr Holladay made a motion to individually meter the apartments at Pine Lane and Pine Village and to ask City Attorney J Ronald Mullins, Jr. to work out an agreement with Norsouth.

Ms Sullivan seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous.

Zoning Hearing:

The Mayor announced that there will be a zoning hearing Tuesday, September 22, 1992 at 6 o'clock P. M. in the Town Hall.

Elected Officials Dinner:

Mayor Edgar announced that West Point will host the quarterly Elected Officials Dinner on Thursday, September 24, 1992 at 6:30 P.M. in the Callaway Gardens Conference Center.

Re-cycling Collection Point:

Ms Sullivan made a motion to place a re-cycling collection structure on the grounds the the Pine Mountain Police Department. The cost of the structure to be approximately \$3,000.00.

Mr Holladay seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous.

Unopened Streets:

Mr Henry A Mullins and Mrs Evelyn Hargett appeared before the Council to discuss the ownership of unopened streets. Mr. Mullins requested a deed for the unopened streets crossing his property. The matter was tabled for later discussion.

Ms Sullivan made a motion that the meeting be closed.

Mr Holladay seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous.

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council of the Town of Pine Mountain, Georgia support family oriented activities for the betterment of the Community, and

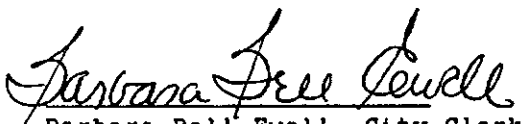
WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council of the Town of Pine Mountain, Georgia recognize the value of tourists to this area,
