

ZONING HEARING
September 22, 1992

A zoning hearing, properly advertised, was held in the City Hall on the afternoon of September 22, 1992 at 6 o'clock P. M.

Mayor James V Edgar presided with Councilpersons J Richard Beall, Franklin D Boykin, P C Holladay, Vance C Smith and Patricia E Sullivan in attendance.

The purpose of the hearing was to act upon an application from W Kendrick Askew, Ida Sullivan Blythe and Alice Askew Furlow to rezone 8.278 acres in Land Lot 60, 3rd Land District, Parcels 57 and 58 of map 56, from C-2 to C-3.

Mr. Askew spoke before the hearing to present his thoughts on the benefits which would flow to the town if the property were rezoned and to respond to the six elements in the Town of Pine Mountain Zoning Ordinance for the rezoning of property.

Mr. Roger Childers, representing some of the residents of Mountainbrook, spoke in opposition to the proposed zoning change.

Mr. Askew spoke in rebuttal.

Mayor Edgar closed the public hearing.

Mr. Boykin made a motion to deny the application of rezoning.

Mr. Holladay seconded the motion.

Mr. Boykin, Mr. Holladay, Mr. Beall and Mr. Smith voted in favor of the motion.

Ms. Sullivan voted in opposition to the motion.

There being no further business, the meeting was closed.
