

ACTS OF THE COUNCIL

April 12, 1993

The Town Council of the Town of Pine Mountain met in regular session on the evening of April 12, 1993 at seven o'clock P M in the Town Hall.

Mayor James V Edgar presided with Councilmen J Richard Beall, Franklin D Boykin, P C Holladay and Vance Smith in attendance.

Pine Mountain Tourism Association:

Mr Jack Drescher appeared before the Council to present a report of recent activities.

Subdivision Ordinance - Second Reading:

Upon motion by Mr Beall, seconded by Mr Smith and agreed upon by all, the Subdivision Ordinance was adopted.

Beer and Wine Application - Margaret Brochu:

Upon motion by Mr Holladay, seconded by Mr Boykin and agreed upon by all, Mrs Brochu of the Grapevine Restaurant was granted an on premises beer and wine license.

Zoning - W Ken Askew:

Mr W Ken Askew appeared before the Council to request that the zoning ordinance be amended in several ways. Mr Askew requested that the 20' setback requirement in C1 be deleted and that the parking requirements in C1 be changed so that off-street parking spaces not be required. Mr Askew also desired rapid action be taken on his requests.

Streets - Al Boyd:

Mr Al Boyd appeared before the Council to complain about the potholes in the Gardenvue extension and demand that the Town take measures to grade and gravel the road.

ISTEA:

Mayor Edgar announced to the Council that there will be a seminar in Atlanta on April 23rd and 24 to explain the new Intermodal Surface Transportation Efficiency Act. Mayor Edgar stated that he could not attend, but hoped that some of the Council could do so.

Precision Planning - Grants:

Mayor Edgar announced to the Council that Jerry Hood of Precision Planning has informed the Town that If the President's Economic Stimulus package is passed by the Congress, there will be grants awarded to cities with ready-to-go projects. The Town's downtown revitalization program can be ready in a very short time. To prove that the project will benefit at least 51% low and moderate income citizens, there will have to be a survey conducted. It was the consensus of the Council that the Town should proceed to compete for these funds.

Budget FY/93-94:

The Mayor announced that the first budget preparation meeting will be Tuesday, April 20 in the Town Hall at 7:30 P M.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned.
