

ACTS OF THE COUNCIL
December 13, 1993

The Town Council of the Town of Pine Mountain, Georgia met in regular session on the evening of Monday, December 13, 1993.

Mayor James V. Edgar presided with Councilpersons J. Richard Beall, Franklin D. Boykin, P. C. Holladay, Vance C. Smith, Sr. and Patricia E. Sullivan in attendance.

PINE MOUNTAIN TOURISM ASSOCIATION:

Mr. Jack Dresher of the Pine Mountain Tourism Association appeared before the Council to report on current activities.

PRECISION PLANNING:

Mr. Jerry Hood of Precision Planning, Inc. appeared before the Council to discuss the Downtown Beautification project.

Upon motion by Mr. Boykin, seconded by Mr. Holladay and affirmed by all, a contract document for engineering services was approved.

BEER AND WINE APPLICATION:

Mayor Edgar gave the first reading of an application for a beer and wine off premises license for Moneyback.

BUSINESS LICENSE FEES:

Mr. Holladay made a motion to set the 1994 business license fee at \$75.00. This fee to exclude flea markets.

Mr. Boykin seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous.

FLEA MARKET BUSINESS LICENSE FEE:

Mr. Boykin made a motion that the flea market business license fee be set at \$75.00 for 1994.

The motion died for lack of a second.

Ms. Sullivan made a motion to set a flea market business license fee at \$100.00 for 1994.

Mr. Beall seconded the motion.

Ms. Sullivan, Mr. Beall and Mr. Boykin voted in favor of the motion.

Mr. Holladay voted in opposition to the motion.

Mr. Smith abstained from voting.

SANITATION:

Ms. Sullivan made a motion to begin the new sanitation charges, as presented, on the January 1, 1994 billing.

Mr. Beall seconded the motion and the vote was unanimously in favor of the motion.

BUDGET:

Ms. Sullivan made a motion to amend the General Funds budget to include \$31,000.00 receipts and expenditures in the sanitation category.

Mr. Smith seconded the motion and the vote was unanimously in favor of the motion.

FIRE ARMS:

Mr H A Mullins appeared before the Council to request the legalization of the firing of firearms within the Town limits.

ADJOURNMENT:

Mr Beall made a motion that the meeting be adjourned. Mr Holladay seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous.
