

ACTS OF THE COUNCIL

February 8, 1993

The City Council of the Town of Pine Mountain met in regular session on the evening of February 8, 1993 at seven o'clock P. M. in the Town Hall.

Mayor James V Edgar presided with Councilpersons J R Beall, Franklin D Boykin, Vance C Smith and Patricia E Sullivan in attendance.

Minutes - January 11, 1993:

Upon motion by Ms Sullivan, seconded by Mr Beall and approved by all, the minutes of January 11, 1993 were approved as written.

Pine Mountain Youth Sports:

Mr Jamie Duke, representative from the Pine Mountain Youth Sports, appeared before the Council to report on the meeting between the Youth Sports Association and Mr Beall and Mr Boykin.

Mr Duke expressed concerns about grass on the field, bathroom facilities for the youth and storage space for the equipment.

It was suggested that the Town might be able to cut the grass weekly and the gym might be used as a solution for both bathroom and storage.

Mayor Edgar appointed Mr Boykin and Ms Sullivan to serve on a committee to coordinate youth sports activities.

W Kendrick Askew - Streets:

Mr W Kendrick Askew appeared before the Council to request the Town open the street Crossing ten acres at the end of Harris Street.

The documentation presented with the request will be sent to the City Attorney, J Ronald Mullins, Jr.

Lower Chattahoochee APDC:

Traci Hadaway of the Lower Chattahoochee Area Planning and Development Commission appeared before the Council to discuss proposed sign and subdivision ordinances.

Mrs. Hadaway also discussed various grants which are available.

Mr Boykin made a motion to apply for a housing improvement grant.

Ms Sullivan seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous.

Beer and Wine Application:

Mayor Edgar gave the first reading of an application for on premises beer and wine from Peter and Margaret Brochu of the Grapevine Restaurant.

Bid Opening - Beautification:

Mayor Edgar announced that the bid opening for the downtown beautification project will take place On Friday, February 26th at the Town Hall at 3 o'clock P M.

Payroll:

Mayor Edgar presented the cost figures for having the payroll done by a payroll company.

The results were as follows:

ADP	\$44.74 weekly	\$2,326.48 annually
Paychex	35.70 weekly	1,856.40 annually
Elmore	57.69 weekly	3,000.00 annually

The matter was tabled for study.

Streets - Henry A Mullins:

Mr. Mullins appeared before the Council to present documentation and request a quit claim deed for the unopened streets running across his property. The documentation will be sent to the City Attorney.

Water Bill - Garden Cottage:

Mayor Edgar presented a request from Mr. James Mitcham, III to review his bill at the Garden Cottage Gift Shop.

Mr Boykin made a motion that the entire bill be paid in installments.

Ms Sullivan seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous.

The Council retired into executive session at this point.

The meeting resumed after approximately fifteen minutes.

Agreement - Norsouth:

Mr Beall made a motion that Mayor Edgar sign any agreement reached with Norsouth, Inc concerning water.

Upon motion by Ms Sullivan, seconded by Mr Boykin and agreed upon by all, the meeting was adjourned.
