

Acts of The Town Council  
June 14, 1993

The City Council sat in regular session on the evening of June 14, 1993 at 7:00 o'clock P. M. in the Council Chambers of the Town Hall.

Mayor James V Edgar presided with Councilpersons J R Beall, Franklin D Boykin, P C Holladay, Vance C Smith, Sr and Patricia E Sullivan in attendance.

Minutes - May 10 and June 7, 1993:

Upon motion by Mr Holladay, seconded by Mr Beall and agreed to by all, the minutes of the May 10th and June 7th meetings were approved as written.

Pine Mountain Tourism Association:

Mr Jack Drescher of the Pine Mountain Tourism Association appeared before the Council to present a report on the Spring season.

Annexation - Harry and Lois Boyd:

Mr Harry Boyd appeared before the Council to present an application of annexation of 32.41 acres north of Meadow Springs drive. The Council heard the first reading of this application.

Citizen Complaint:

Mr Jesse N Champion, Jr appeared before the Council, representing himself and some of his neighbors, to present a complaint of noise and disruption in their neighborhood. The floor was opened for discussion and others addressed the issue.

Quit Claim Deeds - A H and Alice Mullins:

Mr Holladay made a motion that three quit claim deeds on unopened streets be executed. Two deeds to be to Mr A H Mullins and one deed to Mrs Alice Mullins.

Mr Smith seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous.

Cheree' Pitcovich - Business License:

Ms Cheree' Pitcovich appeared before the Council to request a variance on the Electronic Game Machine license.

Ms. Sullivan made a motion not to approve a variance of the license ordinance.

The motion died for lack of a second.

Mr Boykin made a motion to lower the license to \$25.00 per machine.

The motion died for lack of a second.

Mr Beall made a motion to set a license at \$100.00 per machine for ten machines or less and \$25.00 per machine per each machine for all over the first ten machines.

Mr Holladay seconded the motion.

Mr Beall and Mr Holladay voted in favor of the motion.

Mr Boykin and Ms Sullivan voted in opposition to the motion.

Mr Smith abstained from voting.

Mayor Edgar tie-breaking vote was in favor of the motion.

Vance C Smith - Annexation:

Mayor Edgar gave the second reading of an application of annexation by Mr Vance C Smith, Sr.

Mr Holladay made a motion to approve the application.

Ms Sullivan seconded the motion.

The vote was unanimous.

Application - Beer and Wine License:

Mayor Edgar gave the first reading of an application by Billy Sensing for a beer and wine license for the Starlite Grill.

Precision Planning, Inc - Engineering Agreement:

Mayor Edgar presented an agreement for services from PPI, Inc.

The Council asked that Mr Jerry Hood appear before the Council to explain the services and the agreement.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned.
