

ACTS OF THE COUNCIL

March 8, 1993

The City Council of the Town of Pine Mountain met in regular session on the evening of March 8, 1993 at 7 o'clock P. M. in the Town Hall.

Mayor James V Edgar presided with Councilpersons J Richard Beall, Franklin D Boykin, P C Holladay, Vance C Smith and Patricia E Sullivan in attendance.

Minutes - February 8, 1993:

Upon motion by Ms Sullivan, seconded by Mr Holladay, the minutes of the February 8 meeting were approved as written.

Minutes - February 26, 1993:

Upon motion by Mr Holladay, seconded by Mr Beall, the minutes of the February 26 meeting were approved as written.

Unopened Streets - Charles White:

Mr Charles White appeared before the Council to request that LaGrange Avenue not be opened.

A. H. Mullins:

Mr A H Mullins appeared before the Council to request that the lawn area in front of the Post Office be paved.

Mr Mullins further requested that the oak tree in front of the Chipley Archives building be removed.

Franklin Davenport, General Superintendent, reported that the concrete required to pave in front of the Post Office would be \$325.50.

Pine Mountain Volunteer Fire Department:

Wayne Hollaway, of the Pine Mountain Volunteer Fire Department appeared before the Council to present an annual report.

James Copeland presented a 1993 update to the report.

Thomas Scott presented an equipment report and announced that there would be an equipment exhibit after the meeting.

Unopened Streets - John and Carolyn Whorton:

John and Carolyn Whorton appeared before the Council to request a quit claim deed to the roadway upon which their home was constructed.

Ms. Sullivan made a motion to execute the deed. Mr Holladay seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous.

Beer and Wine - Second Reading:

The Council held the second reading of an application by Margaret Brochu of Grapevine Restaurant for on premises beer and wine sales. The vote was tabled for lack of the fingerprint results.

Subdivision Ordinance - First Reading:

Mayor Edgar gave the first reading of the Subdivision Ordinance. There will be a public hearing on the ordinance on March 15th.

Downtown Beautification:

Mayor Edgar announced that a new bid has been received from Darda Construction, deleting the first island and demolition. The new bid is in the amount of \$30,348.00.

The new bid is within the budget range for the project.

Mr. Beall made a motion to award the bid to Darda Construction in the amount of \$30,348.00.

Ms Sullivan seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous.

Sidewalk at Post Office:

Ms Sullivan made a motion to pave the green area in front of the Post Office at the cost of \$325.00.

Mr Holladay seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous.

Recycling:

Mr Holladay announced that the recycling center is now open.

The categories of collection are newspaper, clear glass, amber glass, #1 plastic, #2 plastic, aluminum cans and steel cans.

Pine Mountain Tourism:

Mr Jack Drescher of the Pine Mountain Tourism Association appeared before the Council to present a report.

Substandard Housing Grant:

Mayor Edgar announced that there will be a Public Hearing as part of the process of application for a grant to upgrade substandard housing.

Elected Officials Dinner:

Mayor Edgar announced that Pine Mountain will host the quarterly elected officials dinner on Thursday, March 25th in Room 113 of the Callaway Conference Center.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned.
