

ACTS OF THE COUNCIL
November 8, 1993

The Town of Pine Mountain met in regular session on the evening of November 8, 1993 at seven o'clock P M in the Town Hall.

Mayor James V Edgar presided with Councilpersons J Richard Beall, Franklin D Boykin, P C Holladay, Vance C Smith and Patricia E Sullivan in attendance.

Minutes - October 11, 1993:

Upon motion by Ms Sullivan, seconded by Mr Holladay and agreed upon by all, the Acts of October 11, 1993, were approved as written.

Solid Waste - Bid Opening:

Mayor Edgar opened the bids received for the collection and disposal of solid waste which were as follows:

MTI:

Door to Door \$11.00/ per consumer
Commercial \$20.00/ per consumer
Three year minimum contract.

\$38.00 per ton

ITEM I - DOOR TO DOOR PICK-UP AND DISPOSAL

Option A - Once per week curbside pick-up using residents' containers (up to 4, 30 gallon cans per week), with the Town of Pine Mountain responsible for billing. \$8.99 per month, per unit.

Option B - Once per week curbside pick-up using Waste Away Group owned 90 gallon carts (no deposit required from resident), with the Town of Pine Mountain responsible for billing, \$9.59 per month, per unit.

Option C - Once per week curbside pick-up using residents' containers (up to 4, 30 gallon cans per week), with Waste Away Group responsible for billing. \$10.49 per month, per unit.

Option D - Once per week curbside pick-up using Waste Away owned 90 gallon carts (no deposit required from resident), with Waste Away Group responsible for billing. \$11.09 per month, per unit.

All prices include disposal costs:

ITEM II - Disposal only with the Town of Pine Mountain

bringing solid waste to a transfer station. Waste Away Group will accept waste from the Town of Pine Mountain at the LaGrange Transfer Station at a rate of \$30.29 per ton.

Mr Holladay made a motion to award Waste Away the bid with the Town picking up the garbage and taking it to the Transfer Station at the rate of \$30.29/ton.

Mr Beall seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous.

Water Tank:

Mr Holladay made a motion that the Town notify Owens Contractors, Inc that the Town desires to void the maintenance contract and request a refund of \$3,900.00 paid for FY 93/94.

Ms Sullivan seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous.

Nuisance Ordinance - Second Reading:

Ms Sullivan made a motion to adopt the ordinance.

Mr Boykin seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous.

Business License Ordinance - Second Reading:

Ms Sullivan made a motion to adopt the ordinance.

Mr Holladay seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous.

Gym:

Mayor Edgar read a letter from Janet Williamson, Youth Coordinator of the First Methodist Church requesting the use of the gym one Sunday afternoon per month for youth activities.

Ms Sullivan made a motion to grant the use of the gym for this purpose.

Mr Boykin seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous.

Street Lights:

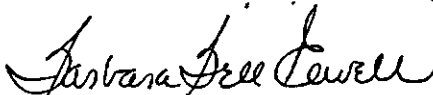
Ms Sullivan made a motion to add three street lights on South Main Street.
