

ACTS OF THE COUNCIL
April 11, 1994

The Town Council of the Town of Pine Mountain sat in regular session on the evening of April 11, 1994 at seven o'clock P M in the Town Hall.

Mayor James V Edgar presided with Councilpersons J Richard Beall, Franklin D Boykin, P C Holladay, Vance C Smith and Patricia E Sullivan in attendance.

MINUTES - MARCH 14, MARCH 22, APRIL 8:

Upon motion by Ms Sullivan, seconded by Mr Holladay and unanimously approved, the minutes of the March 14, March 22 and April 8, 1994 meetings were approved as written.

PINE MOUNTAIN TOURISM ASSOCIATION:

Mr Jack Dresher appeared before the Council to present the report for March.

BID OPENING - ROOFS:

One bid was received for the repair of the roofs at the Town Hall and the Police Department.

The bid from Yoder Brothers was as follows:

Police Station	\$14,542.00
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Town Hall	7,046.00
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Mr Holladay made a motion to accept the bid if the materials to be used meet the Harris County Building Code.

Mr Smith seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous.

BID OPENING - BALLPARK FENCE:

Mayor Edgar announced one bid had been received for the fencing of the softball field.

The bid from American Fence Products was \$4,389.00.

Ms Sullivan made a motion that the bid be accepted.

Mr Holladay seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous.

BID OPENING - SIDEWALKS:

Mayor Edgar announced that the bid opening for the next phase of the beautification project had been opened on Friday, April 8, 1994.

The bid from Darda Construction Company was for \$50,750.00.

Mr Holladay made a motion to accept the bid.

Mr Boykin seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous.

COMPLAINT - WILLIE JOE GRIER PROPERTY:

Mayor Edgar presented a petition from ten residents near the residence owned by Willie Joe Grier protesting the condition of the property.

The decision was made to enforce the condemnation ordinance.

PINE MOUNTAIN VOLUNTEER FIRE DEPARTMENT:

Fire Chief Otto Medick of the Pine Mountain Volunteer Fire Department appeared before the Council to present a report on the recent activities.

Chief Medick announced there will be a Bar-B-Que on May 28th at the Corner Shops.

W KENDRICK ASKEW:

Mr Askew appeared before the Council to request that the rose bush be removed at the highway entrance in front of Mrs Irene Sivell's property.

BRIAN HITE:

Mr Hite appeared before the Council to discuss the condition of the floor at the gym and the goals having been pulled down.

REGIONAL DEVELOPMENT COMMISSION - CRISSY MARLOWE:

Mayor Edgar announced that the Council will meet with Ms Marlowe on the evening of April 20th at 6:30 P M in the Town Hall.
