

ACTS OF THE COUNCIL
February 14, 1994

The Town Council of the Town of Pine Mountain sat in regular session on the evening of February 14th 1994 at seven o'clock P.M. in the Town Hall.

Mayor James V Edgar presided with Councilpersons J Richard Bell, Franklin D Boykin, P C Holladay, Vance C Smith and Patricia E Sullivan in attendance.

ACTS OF THE COUNCIL - JANUARY 10, 1994

Upon motion by Ms Sullivan, seconded by Mr Holladay and approved by all, the minutes of the January 10th meeting were approved as written.

PINE MOUNTAIN TOURISM ASSOCIATION:

Mr Jack Drescher of the Pine Mountain Tourism Association appeared before the Council to present a report on the January activities.

AREA AGENCY ON AGING - MEG BRADLEY:

Mrs Meg Bradley of the Area Agency on Aging appeared before the Council to request a donation to the Senior Citizens Center be incorporated in the FY 94/95 budget.

Ms. Sullivan made a motion to donate \$1,500.00 to provide meals for Pine Mountain citizens attending the center.

Mr Boykin seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous.

LOWER CHATTAHOOCHEE - CHRISTI MARLOWE:

Miss Christi Marlowe of the Lower Chattahoochee Area Development Commission appeared before the Council to discuss the development of a Preservation Commission.

The Council asked Miss Marlowe to draft an ordinance for consideration.

PINE MOUNTAIN YOUTH SPORTS ASSOCIATION:

Mr Robert McGee of the Pine Mountain Youth Sports Association appeared before the Council to present trophies won by Pine Mountain youth teams. These trophies are to be kept in the Town Hall.

Mr McGee also discussed the use of the softball field to sponsor an adult league. The proceeds from this usage would be used for the youth sports and field upkeep.

Mr McGee and the Council discussed the immediate need for repairs or changes at the park.

DWELLING NUMBERING ORDINANCE - FIRST READING:

Mayor Edgar presented the first reading of an ordinance for E911 establishing a unified manner of numbering dwellings in Pine Mountain.

LOCAL AGREEMENT FOR E 911:

Ms Sullivan made a motion to adopt an agreement for E911.

Mr Boykin seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous.

ROOFS - POLICE STATION AND TOWN HALL:

General Superintendent Franklin Davenport was asked to secure estimates for repairing the roof at the Town Hall and estimates for placing a sliding roof at the Police Station.

HEARING - WETLANDS:

Ms Sullivan made a motion to hold a public hearing for the wetlands application on March 14, 1994 at 6:30 P M.

Mr Boykin seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous.

Upon motion by Ms Sullivan, seconded by Mr Holladay and agreed upon by all, the meeting was adjourned.
