

ACTS OF THE COUNCIL

January 10, 1994

The Town Council of the Town of Pine Mountain sat in regular session on the evening of January 10, 1994.

Mayor James V Edgar presided with Councilpersons J Richard Beall, P C Holladay, Vance C Smith, and Patricia E Sullivan in attendance.

Minutes - December 13th, December 21st and December 28th:

Upon motion by Mr Holladay, seconded by Mr Beall and unanimously agreed upon the minutes of the December meetings were approved as written.

Harris County Community Development - Tracey Hadaway:

Mrs Tracey Hadaway of the Harris County Community Development Department appeared before the Council to discuss the formation of a design review committee.

Ms Sullivan made a motion to approve a design review study.

Mr Beall seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous.

Beer and Wine Application - 2nd reading:

Mayor Edgar read the application of a beer and wine license for Moneyback.

Mr Holladay made a motion that the license be approved.

Mr Smith seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous.

Mayor Pro-Tem:

Mr Smith nominated Ms Sullivan to serve as the Mayor Pro-Tem. Mr Beall seconded the nomination and Mr Smith, Mr Beall and Mr Holladay voted in favor of the nomination. Ms Sullivan abstained from voting.

Business License - Quality Promotions, Inc.:

Mr Franklin Davenport asked that the Council waive the business license for Quality Promotions, Inc, who are in the process of soliciting donations for the Fire Chiefs Council of Harris County and selling photographs.

Ms Sullivan made a motion that the license be waived.

Mr Beall seconded the motion and the vote was unanimously in favor of the motion.

Legal Ads:

Ms Sullivan made a motion to place legal ads in both the Harris County Journal and the Harris County Herald.

Mr Beall seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous.

Executive Session:

The Council retired into executive session at 7:40 P. M.

The meeting was reopened at 7:45 P. M. and upon motion by Mr Holladay, seconded by Mr Smith and agreed upon by all, the meeting was adjourned.
