

ACTS OF THE COUNCIL

September 12, 1994

The City Council of the Town of Pine Mountain sat in regular session on the evening of September 12, 1994 at seven P. M. in the Town Hall.

Mayor James V Edgar presided with Councilpersons Franklin D Boykin, P. C. Holladay, Vance C. Smith, Sr. and Patricia E. Sullivan in attendance.

PINE MOUNTAIN TOURISM ASSOCIATION - JACK DRESHER:

Mr Dresher appeared before the Council to present the contract between the Town of Pine Mountain and the Pine Mountain Tourism Association. Mr. Holladay made a motion that the contract be signed as presented and to authorize the Assistant Town Clerk, Mary Jean Barnes, to attest to the signatures on the document.

Ms. Sullivan seconded the motion.

Councilman Smith voted in the affirmative.

Councilman Boykin voted in the affirmative.

CGRI - ROGER CHILDERS:

Mr. Childers appeared before the Council to address the issue of traffic during the Fantasy in Lights season.

HEAVY VEHICLES - JOHN WALTER STOWERS:

Mr. Stowers, developer of Springdale Farms, appeared before the Council to request the Town not to allow eighteen wheel trucks to traverse the streets in the sub-division. Mr. Stowers asked that the Council take action to restrict the use of heavy vehicles in residential areas. Mr Joe Manning spoke in favor of all vehicles having access to the streets.

The matter was delayed pending upon Mr. Stowers learning whether he can amend the restricted covenants of the sub-division:

BEER AND WINE APPLICATION - SECOND READING - JOE CORNETT:

Mayor Edgar presented the second reading of a beer and wine license application by Joe Cornett for the City Cafe.

Mr. Holladay made a motion that the license be granted.

Ms. Sullivan seconded the motion.

Mr. Boykin voted in the affirmative.

Mr. Smith voted in the affirmative.

CONTRACT - HARRIS COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT - COURTS:

Mayor Edgar presented the annual contract with Harris County for all services related to zoning to the Council.

Ms. Sullivan made a motion that the contract be accepted.

Mr. Holladay seconded the motion.

Mr. Boykin voted in the affirmative.

Mr. Smith voted in the affirmative.

PINE MOUNTAIN VOLUNTEER FIRE DEPARTMENT:

Fire Chief Otto Medek appeared before the Council to ask that the Town take the title of the fire truck donated to the PMVFD.

Ms. Sullivan made a motion that the Town take title and insure both vehicles owned by the Town. Ms Sullivan further moved that the Town insure out of town firemen who come to the Town's rescue and that, under no circumstances require the PMVFD to respond only to fires in the Town Limits.

Mr. Holladay seconded the motion.

Mr. Boykin voted in the affirmative.

Mr. Smith voted in the affirmative.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned.
