

ACTS OF THE COUNCIL
August 14, 1995

The Town Council of the Town of Pine Mountain, Georgia sat in regular session on the evening of Monday, August 14, 1995 at seven o'clock P M in the Town Hall.

Mayor James V Edgar presided with Councilpersons J Richard Beall, Franklin D Boykin, P C Holladay and Vance C Smith in attendance.

ACTS OF THE COUNCIL - JULY 10, 1995:

Mr Beall made a motion that the minutes be approved as written.

Mr Holladay seconded the motion.

Mr Boykin and Mr Smith voted in favor of the motion.

COMPLAINT - ALLENE JONES:

Mrs Jones appeared before the Council to complain about the noise and fumes being generated by trucks parking on the lot next to her home. Mayor Edgar and the Council agreed to speak with the Town's attorney about the matter.

PINE MOUNTAIN TOURISM - JACK DRESHER:

Mr Dresher appeared before the Council to present the report for July.

AMENDMENT TO NUISANCE ORDINANCE:

Mr Holladay made a motion to amend the nuisance ordinance in the following manner:

Section IV change "Mayor's Court" to "Municipal Court".

Change "Mayor" to "Municipal Court Judge".

Mr Smith seconded the motion.

Mr Beall and Mr Boykin voted in approval of the motion.

CHATTAHOOCHEE-FLINT HERITAGE HIGHWAY:

Mr Holladay made a motion that a resolution in support of the Chattahoochee-Flint Heritage Highway be passed.

Mr Boykin seconded the motion.

Mr Beall and Mr Smith voted in favor of the motion.

AMENDMENT TO ELECTION ORDINANCE:

Mr Boykin made a motion to change the Election Ordinance by changing Section III, Subsection A to read "Each candidate shall file notice of candidate in the office of the Municipal Election Superintendent from September 4th to September 8th, 1995 between the hours of 8:30 to 12:00 A M and 1:00 to 4:00 P M.

Section III, Subsection B - delete.

Mr Beall seconded the motion.

Mr Holladay and Mr Smith voted in approval of the motion.

GEORGIA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION - SPEED LIMIT

Mr Beall made a motion to grant approval for the Georgia Department of Transportation to temporarily reduce speed limits on any federal, state or other route within The Town of Pine Mountain as deemed appropriate by the Department during its construction and maintenance activities. Violators may be found guilty of a misdemeanor of a high and aggravated nature and shall be punished by a fine of not less than \$100.00 nor more than \$2,000.00 or by imprisonment for a term not to exceed 12 months, or both.

Mr Holladay seconded the motion.

Mr Boykin and Mr Smith voted in favor of the motion.

The Mayor and Council went into executive session.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned.
