

ACTS OF THE COUNCIL

March 13, 1995

The Town Council sat in regular session on the evening of March 13, 1995 at seven o'clock P M in the Town Hall.

Mayor James V Edgar presided with Councilpersons J Richard Beall, Franklin D Boykin, P C Holladay, Vance C Smith and Patricia E Sullivan in attendance.

PUBLIC HEARING - ZONING ORDINANCE

A public hearing of proposed changes to Section Nine of the Zoning Ordinance was opened by Mayor Edgar.

There was no public comment and the hearing was closed.

PINE MOUNTAIN YOUTH SPORTS-ROBERT MCGEE

Mr Robert McGee appeared before the Council to request permission to utilize the softball field to finance Pine Mountain Youth Sports.

Mr Holladay made a motion to allow Pine Mountain Youth Sports to use the field, and for the Town to drag the field and buy the locks needed to secure the property.

Ms Sullivan seconded the motion.

Mr Beall, Mr Boykin and Mr Smith voted in favor of the motion.

HARRIS COUNTY SENIOR CENTER

Mayor Edgar read a letter from the Area Agency on Aging requesting \$1,500.00 be placed in the budget to help fund the Harris County Senior Center.

Mr Holladay made a motion that the Town put the donation in the FY 95/96 budget.

Ms Sullivan seconded the motion.

Mr Beall, Mr Boykin and Mr Smith voted in favor of the motion.

GYMNASIUM

Mr Ken Askeu appeared before the Council to announce that there will be a school wide reunion on May 6th 1995 at the gymnasium and grounds surrounding the gym.

Mr Askeu asked permission to use the rest rooms at the Town Hall during this reunion.

Mr Askeu further asked the Town's assistance in seeking funds for renovation of the gym and in the maintenance of the gym.

Permission was granted to use the facilities at the Town Hall, and it was explained that the search for grant funds is ongoing.

MERIWETHER COUNTY - L O S T

Mayor Edgar presented to the Council a proposal that the municipalities of Meriwether plan to present to the Meriwether County Board of Commission.

Ms Sullivan made a motion that Pine Mountain sign the proposal.

Mr Holladay seconded the motion.

Mr Beall, Mr Boykin and Mr Smith voted in approval of the motion.

Mr. Jack Dresher appeared before the Council to present the February report of activities.
