November 13, 1995

MINUTES - OCTOBER 9, 1995

OCCUPATION TAX

Ms Sullivan made a motion to pass the 1995 Occupation Tax Ordinance for 1996.

ANIMAL CONTROL ORDINANCE

Mr Holladay made a motion to pass the ordinance with corrections.

Ms Sullivan seconded the motion.

Mr Beall, Mr Boykin and Mr Smith voted in favor of the motion.

ORDINANCE TO IMPOSE PREMIUM TAX ON LIFE INSURANCE SALES

Ms Sullivan made a motion that the Premium Tax Ordinance be passed.

Mr Holladay seconded the motion.

Mr Beall, Mr Boykin and Mr Smith voted in favor of the motion.

PROPERTY TAX MILLAGE - 1995

Ms Sullivan made a motion to adopt the following tax formula

17.2	gross millage
- 8.1	Local Option Sales Tax credit
9.1	Net millage

Mr Holladay seconded the motion.

Mr Beall, Mr Boykin and Mr Smith voted in favor of the motion.

FIRESIDE LEASE

A request to reassign the lease of property at the Fireside Inn was delayed by Council.

EXECUTIVE SESSION

The Mayor and Council retired into executive session.
