

Acts of the Council

February 12, 1996

The Town Council of Pine Mountain sat in regular session on the evening of February 12, 1996, at seven o'clock pm in the Town Hall.

Mayor James V. Edgar presided with Councilpersons J. R. Beall, Franklin D. Boykin, J. C. Holladay, Jarvis Shepherd, and Patricia E. Sullivan in attendance.

MINUTES - JANUARY 8, 1996:

Mrs. Sullivan made a motion the minutes of the January 8, 1996, meeting be approved as written with the correction under "REORGANIZATION", line 5, "form" changed to "from". Mr. Holladay seconded the motion. Mr. Beall, Mr. Boykin, ^{and} Mrs. Shepherd voted in favor of the motion.

FINANCIAL REPORT:

The financial report for the month of January was discussed. No questions.

PINE MOUNTAIN TOURISM ASSOCIATION:

Mr. Jack Drescher was unable to attend. His mother fell and broke her hip. He had to be with her in Columbus. No report was submitted.

MIR. AL BOYD:

Asked if he is allowed to speak Mayor Edgar responded in the affirmative, adding Mr. Boyd has 5 minutes. Mr. Boyd stated he wants to put the Council on notice about the sewage proposal, understanding that the Town now has a permit ^{to put it in}. Mayor Edgar responded the Town has no permit. Boyd continued, he understands the system will be right up against him and the lay of the land will cause both of his ^{ponds} to be contaminated. The surveyor's cut down 8 of his saw-tooth oaks. These were planted 2 feet inside

his lot line and they cut those down rather than cut the limbs off the side. Mayor Edgar asked which survey crew it was because there were 2 crews. Mr. Boyd's answer was he has no idea. Mayor Edgar said he would have Mr. Bollington look at that tomorrow. Mr. Boyd stated he still cannot understand a town ^{installing} ~~figuring~~ on a sewage system which is for less than 20 years, ^{duration.} ~~what~~ He understands ^{this} is the maximum; what do we plan to do in 20 years. When you build a house or buy a house, you don't plan for it to be obsolete in 20 years. Wanted to know what the ruling is; do we vote individually on each person who wishes to address the Council. Mayor Edgar asked him to wait a few more minutes and the issue ^{would} ~~will~~ be cleared up. Boyd referred to a law, "taxation without representation" and feels this ^{applicable to his situation.}

9. PINE MOUNTAIN CHAMBER OF COMMERCE:

Mrs. Nancy Epstein, Pine Mtn. Chamber of Commerce, requested the Town work with the Chamber on renovating and adding trash cans. She requested Mr. Hap Holladay be appointed as the Council representative to work with them, and that the Town agree to work at 50% funding with them. After Mayor Edgar appointed Mr. Holladay to the project, Mrs. Epstein said a report back to the Council will be made as soon as there is anything to report, and thanked the Mayor and Council for their participation.

PINE MOUNTAIN YOUTH SPORTS:

Mr. Robert McGehee reported the 1995 ^{season} ~~years~~ was very successful, and won a championship. He asked for use of the fields again this ^{year} and for Jacob ^{Mc} Walker to drag the ^{out} ~~fields~~ ^{outfields} as needed. The PMYS will again be responsible ^{for} ~~at~~ general maintenance. Mr. Holladay made the motion the Council offer the same support as in 1995; Mrs. Shepherd seconded the motion; Mr. Beall, Mr. Boykin, and Ms. Sullivan voted approval of the motion.

Ms. Pat Sullivan:

Ms. Sullivan referred to "Acts of the Council, February 13, 1995." She read the "Meeting Guidelines" section and pointed out Mr. Frank Boykin made the motion, with Mr. Beall seconding and Mr. Holladay and Ms. Sullivan voting in favor of the motion. Ms. Sullivan ~~made a motion~~ requested "The citizens of the Town of Pine Mountain may place themselves on the agenda. Those who are not citizens of the Town of Pine Mountain may not place themselves on the agenda." be deleted permanently from the records." Mr. Holladay seconded the motion. Mr. Beall, Mr. Boykin, and Mrs. Shepherd voted in favor of the motion.

Ms. Jarvis Shepherd:

Ms. Shepherd requested the Council ~~to~~ pass a Pine Mountain Girl Scout "Be Your Best Day" proclamation ^{for} ~~on~~ March 12, 1996; ^{a/s/o} ~~also~~ asking the Town to fly the Girl Scout flag at the City Hall all day March 12 and wear the " " ribbon and pin to show ^{their} ~~your~~ support. The flag, pins, and ribbons will be supplied by the Girl Scouts. ~~Hap~~ Holladay made the motion the Council adopt the proclamation, and was seconded by Ms. Sullivan. Mr. Beall, Mr. Boykin, and Mrs. Shepherd voted in favor.

Mr. Holladay made a motion the meeting be adjourned. Motion was seconded by Mr. Beall. Mr. Boykin, Mrs. Shepherd, and Ms. Sullivan voted in favor.
