The Town Council of the Town of Pine Mountain sat in regular session on the evening of March 11, 1996.

Mayor James V Edgar presided with Councilpersons J Richard Beall, Franklin D Boykin, Jarvis M Shepherd and Patricia E Sullivan in attendance.

ACTS OF THE COUNCIL - February 12, 1996

Ms Sullivan made a motion that the acts of February 12, 1996 be approved with the correction of a typographical error.

Mr Holladay seconded the motion.

Mr Beall and Mrs Shepherd voted in agreement with the motion.

PINE MOUNTAIN TOURISM ASSOCIATION

Mr Jack Drescher appeared before the Council to present the February report.

BEER AND WINE APPLICATION - RASPBERRY'S

Mayor Edgar presented the first reading of an application to serve beer and wine signed by Wayne Wilkins of Raspberry's Restaurant.

GYMNASIUM - KEN ASKEW

Mr Askew appeared before the Council to announce that the grant application had been denied.

The possibilities of other sources of funding were discussed.

Mr Boykin made a motion to proceed with the investigation of the possibility of a referendum to renovate the gymnasium and to seek approval from the United States Department of Justice.

Mrs Shepherd seconded the motion.

Mr Beall and Ms Sullivan voted in favor of the motion.

PINE MOUNTAIN CHAMBER OF COMMERCE

Mr Rod Rodriguez of the Pine Mountain Chamber of Commerce appeared before the Council to request the Town to participate in the purchase of trash cans.

Ms Sullivan made a motion to authorize the Town to contribute \$1,200.00 toward the purchase of trash cans.

Mr Rodriguez also stated that the Chamber of Commerce is planning a spring celebration during the last weekend in March and the first weekend in April.

A request to close the 200 block of North Commerce Avenue and the 100 block of Broad Street was discussed and Mr Rodriguez was requested to take a poll of the merchants involved and report their opinions back to the Council.

DICTION OF UNDERSTANDING AND AGREEMENTS - FIRE DEPARTMENTS

After a general discussion, which included Mr Otto Medeck, Fire Chief of the Pine Mountain Volunteer Fire Department, Mr Beall made a motion that the Town not sign the dictum.

Mr Boykin seconded the motion.

Ms Sullivan voted in approval of the motion.

Mrs Shepherd abstained from voting.

MERIWETHER COUNTY PROPERTY

Mr Brent Bullington requested hunting rights on the 15 acres in Meriwether County.

Ms Sullivan made a motion that the rights be granted.

Mr Beall seconded the motion.

Mr Boykin and Ms Sullivan voted in favor of the motion.

CEMETERY COMMITTEE

Mr Alf Mullins appeared before the Council to present the report of the Cemetery Committee.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned.
