

ACTS OF THE COUNCIL
September 9, 1996

The Town Council of the Town of Pine Mountain sat in regular session on the evening of September 9, 1996 at seven o'clock P M.

Mayor James V Edgar presided with Councilpersons J Richard Beall, Franklin D Boykin, P C Holladay, Jarvis M Shepherd and Patricia E Sullivan in attendance.

ACTS OF THE COUNCIL - AUGUST 12, 1996

Mr Holladay made a motion that the acts of August 12, 1996 be approved as written.

Mr Boykin seconded the motion.

Mr Beall, Mrs Shepherd and Ms Sullivan voted in approval of the motion.

FINANCIAL REPORT

Mayor Edgar presented the monthly financial report.
There were no questions or comments.

ALCOHOL REQUEST - PETER BROCHU

Mayor gave the first reading of a request for an on premises consumption alcohol license submitted by Peter Brochu.

CHIPLEY HISTORICAL SOCIETY

Mr Franklin Davenport appeared before the Council on behalf of the Chipley Historical Society.

Mr Davenport asked permission to apply for a matching funds grant for \$10,000.00 in order to produce a film of Chipley.

Mr Holladay made a motion that the Chipley Historical Society be given permission to apply for a grant in the name of the Town of Pine Mountain.

Ms Sullivan seconded the motion.

Mr Beall, Mr Boykin and Mrs Shepherd voted in favor of the motion.

GEORGIA 1 AND GEORGIA 354 INTERSECTION

Howard H Callaway, Jr appeared before the Council to discuss the intersection improvement slated for 1997.

Mr Callaway stated that in order to improve the esthetic nature of the intersection, underground wiring and mast arms for the lights would be desirable.

The underground wiring and mast arms would cost an excess of \$29,000.00 to \$31,000.00 above the amount that the Georgia Department of Transportation plan to spend on the wiring and lighting.

Mr Callaway requested that the Town contribute one third of the additional cost.

Callaway Gardens Resort, Inc and Boyd Boys, Inc will each contribute one third of the additional cost.

Mr Harry Boyd also spoke in favor of the project.

Ms Sullivan made a motion that the Town of Pine Mountain contribute one third of the cost of the project.

Mr Holladay seconded the motion.

Mr Beall, Mr Boykin and Mrs Shepherd voted in approval of the motion.

MILAGE - 1996

Mr Holladay made a motion that the following formula be adopted for the purpose of levying property taxes for FY 96/97.

Gross milage	17.21
LOST credit	7.88
Net milage	9.33

Ms Sullivan seconded the motion.

Mr Beall, Mr Boykin and Mrs Shepherd voted in agreement with the motion.

The Council meeting was closed as 7:30 P M in order to hold a public hearing.
