

ACTS OF THE COUNCIL

October 13, 1997

The Town Council of the Town of Pine Mountain, Georgia sat in regular session on the evening of Monday, October 13, 1997 at seven o'clock P. M. in the Town Hall.

Mayor James V. Edgar presided with Councilpersons J. Richard Beall, Franklin D. Boykin, W. Mitchell Chason and P. C. "Hap" Holladay in attendance.

ACTS OF THE COUNCIL - SEPTEMBER 8TH AND 22ND, 1997

Mr. Holladay made a motion that the Acts of September 8, 1997 ~~and the Acts of September 22, 1997~~ be approved as written.

Mr. Chason seconded the motion.

Mr. Boykin and Mr. Holladay voted in approval of the motion.

FINANCIAL REPORT - SEPTEMBER

Mayor Edgar presented the financial report for September.

PUBLIC HEARING - ZONING

Mayor Edgar suspended the meeting to hold a properly advertised public hearing at 7:05 P. M.

The meeting reconvened at 7:13 P. M.

Mr. Boykin made a motion to restore Mr. Dowis' property to R3.

Mr. Holladay seconded the motion.

Mr. Boykin and Mr. Holladay voted in favor of the motion.

Mr. Beall and Mr. Chason voted in opposition to the motion.

Mayor Edgar exercised his tie-breaking privilege and voted in favor of the motion.

PINE MOUNTAIN YOUTH SPORTS ASSOCIATION - ROBERT McGEE

Mr. McGee appeared before the Council to offer appreciation for the support given the Pine Mountain Youth Sports.

Mr. McGee asked permission to utilize the gymnasium this fall for practice while preparing for the basketball season.

Mr. McGee further requested permission to once again use the softball field to sponsor an adult softball league. The proceeds from this endeavor help support Pine Mountain Youth Sports.

The Council gave permission to use the gymnasium this fall and suggested that Mr. McGee ask permission for the use of the field after the new Council takes office in January.

ANNEXATION - CHARLES WHITE

Mr. White appeared before the Council to request that 32 acres off West Georgia Avenue annexed into the Town Limits.

Mr. White was informed of the annexation process.

SPEEDBUMPS - BLANCHARD AVENUE - MARTHA SLEDGE

Ms. Sledge appeared before the Council to request that speedbumps be placed on North Blanchard Avenue, due to the inordinate amount of speeding traffic on that street.

Mr. James Stone also spoke in favor of speedbumps on North Blanchard Avenue.

Mr. Holladay made a motion that speedbumps be placed on North Blanchard Avenue if the Georgia Department of Transportation has no objections.

Mr. Boykin seconded the motion.

Mr. Beall and Mr. Boykin voted in agreement with the motion.

APPOINTMENT TO COUNCIL

Mr. Edgar announced that Mrs. Jarvis Shepherd had vacated her Council seat to qualify to run for Mayor.

In accordance to the Charter of the Town of Pine Mountain, the vacant seat was advertised with the last day to apply for appointment having been October 7th.

The Municipal Clerk was asked to make appointments with each applicant on Monday, October 20, 1997.

Mr. Brian Hinson appeared before the Council to present a lease purchase plan for computer software, support and maintenance. The software is to include Utility Billing, Accounting/Budget, and Occupational Tax.

Mr. Chason made a motion to accept the bid of \$30,000.00.

Mr. Beall and Mr. Holladay voted in agreement with the motion.
