ACTS OF THE COUNCIL

Mr Beall made a motion that the Acts of December be approved as written.

FINANCIAL REPORT

Mayor Teel presented the Financial Report for December, 1997.

REORGANIZATION

Mayor Pro-Tem

Mr Chason made a motion that Mr Beall be nominated for Mayor Pro-Tem.

Mrs Pierce voted in agreement with the motion.

Mr Beall abstained from voting.

Legal Organ

Mr Hadley made a motion that the Harris County Herald serve as the legal organ.

Mr Beall seconded the motion.

Mr Chason and Mrs Pierce voted in approval of the motion.

Depository

Mr Chason made a motion that the Depository for the General Funds remain the First Union Bank.

Mr Beall seconded the motion.

Mr Hadley and Mrs Pierce voted in support of the motion.

Mr Beall made a motion that the Depository of the Enterprise Funds remain the First Peoples Bank.

Mr Chason seconded the motion.

Mr Hadley and Mrs Pierce voted in favor of the motion.

CURFEW - HARRIS ADAMS

Mr Adams appeared before the Council to discuss the possibility of a curfew and a Neighborhood watch program.

HABITAT FOR HUMANITY - WAYNE HOLLOWAY

Mr Holloway appeared before the Council to discuss the Harris County Chapter of the Habitat for Humanity program.

Mr Holloway asked that the Mayor and Council help find a suitable site for the first home to be built by the Harris County chapter.

REQUEST FOR SEWERAGE - COURT DOWIS

Mr Dowis appeared before the Council to request that he be allowed to connect his apartment buildings to the Town sewerage system.

The Old Chipley Apartments are in Meriwether County and Mr Dowis stated he would run a line at his own expense to the nearest connection point of the sewerage system. Mr Dowis further stated that he would maintain ownership of the line and maintain the line himself.

The line would run across the property of Mary Milton McGee Guffey.

Mr and Mrs Guffey appeared before the Council and stated that they would allow the line to cross their property with two restrictions: that the line be placed where they wished it to be placed and that the line be dedicated to the Town.

The Mayor and Council directed Mr Brent Bullington, General Superintendent, to meet with both parties at the site to examine the property and discuss the lay of the line.

PINE MOUNTAIN VOLUNTEER FIRE DEPARTMENT - OTTO MEDECK
