

ACTS OF THE COUNCIL
MARCH 9, 1998

The Mayor and Council of the Town of Pine Mountain, Georgia sat in regular session on the evening of March 9, 1998 at seven o'clock P M in the Town Hall.

Mayor Joe D Teel presided with Councilpersons J Richard Beall, William J Champion, W Mitchell Chason, C Lamar Hadley and Tamara M Pierce in attendance.

ACTS OF THE COUNCIL

Mr Chason made a motion that the acts of the February meetings be approved as written.

Mr Hadley seconded the motion.

Mr Beall, Mr Champion and Mrs Pierce voted in favor of the motion.

FINANCIAL REPORT

Mayor Teel presented the financial report for February.

There were no questions or comments.

PINE MOUNTAIN TOURISM ASSOCIATION - HANK ARNOLD

Ms Arnold presented a report on the Facade Grant Program.

PINE MOUNTAIN CHAMBER OF COMMERCE - DR ROBERT EPSTEIN

Dr Epstein reported that there will be a downtown cleanup day on March 21st with an alternate date of March 28th.

ANNEXATION - CHARLES WHITE

Mr White appeared before the Council to present his application for annexation.

Mr Champion made a motion not to annex the property.

Mr Beall seconded the motion.

Mayor Teel called for discussion and the matter was discussed.

Mr Hadley, Mrs Pierce, Mr Beall and Mr Champion voted in support of the motion.

Mr Chason voted in opposition to the motion.

PINE MOUNTAIN KIWANIS CLUB - DR ROBERT EPSTEIN

Dr Epstein appeared before the Council to present a request for the use of the softball field on April 18th with an alternate date of April 25th to have a town wide yard sale.

Mrs Pierce made a motion that the use of the field be granted on these dates.

Mr Beall seconded the motion.

After some discussion, the vote was unanimous in approval of the motion.

PINE MOUNTAIN YOUTH SPORTS - ROBERT MCGHEE

Mr McGhee appeared before the Council to present a report on the activities of the Association.

Basketball, baseball, football and soccer are the sports planned for 1998.

Mr McGhee requested permission to use the ballfield for an adult softball league, the proceeds of which will be used to help fund the Pine Mountain Youth Sports Association.

Mr Beall made a motion to allow the Pine Mountain Youth Sports Association to use the field again this year.

Mr Hadley seconded the motion.

The vote was unanimous.

BOND ORDINANCE

Mr Beall made a motion to pass an ordinance for the issuance of a Town of Pine Mountain water and sewer revenue bond, series 1998A in the principal amount of \$829,200.00, and a Town of Pine Mountain Water and Sewer Revenue Bond, Series 1998B, in the Principal amount of \$83,570.00.

Mr Chason seconded the motion.

The vote was unanimous in support of the motion.

GYMNASIUM - BILL CHAMPION

Mr Champion made a motion to lease the gymnasium to the Pine Mountain Community Center Foundation.

Mr Chason seconded the motion.

After discussion, the motion was rescinded and the matter was delayed.

ADJOURNMENT

Mr Chason made a motion that the meeting be adjourned.

Mr Hadley seconded the motion.

The vote was unanimous in favor with the motion.
