May 11, 1998

The Town Council of the Town of Pine Mountain sat in regular session on the evening of Monday, May 11, 1998 at seven o'clock P M in the Town Hall.

Mayor Joe D Teel, Jr presided with Councilpersons J Richard Beall, William J Champion, W Mitchell Chason, C Lamar Hadley and Tamara M Pierce in attendance.

ZONING CHANGE REQUEST - CHARLES WHITE

Mr Chason made a motion that the request of Mr Charles White to change the zoning of his property from A-1 to R-1 be considered and approved.

Mr Hadley seconded the motion.

Mr Beall, Mr Champion and Mrs Pierce voted in favor of the motion.

ACTS OF THE COUNCIL - APRIL, 1998

Mr Champion made a motion that the Acts of April, 1998 be approved as written.

Mr Beall seconded the motion.

Mr Chason, Mr Hadley and Mrs Pierce voted in agreement with the motion.

PINE MOUNTAIN CHAMBER OF COMMERCE

Dr Robert Epstein presented the Chamber of Commerce report.

Dr Epstein requested that the Mayor sign a proclamation that June 6th be Robert "Little Fox" McGhee day in Pine Mountain, to honor Mr McGhee for his long and tireless dedication to the youth of the area.

Dr Epstein reported that the Merchants Association plan to have "I Love Pine Mountain" day on June 6th, and requested that North Commerce Avenue be closed from # 140 to # 160 on that date.

BEER AND WINE APPLICATION - SECOND READING

Mayor Teel presented the application of Mr Loring Perez for a beer and wine license for the second reading.

Mr Dallas Storms, Ms Sally Sharpless, Mr Dan Doulet and Dr Mark Smith spoke in opposition to the issuance of the license.

Mayor Teel announced that the criminal history had not been received from the FBI and the vote would have to be deferred.

BEER AND WINE APPLICATION - FIRST READING

Mayor Teel presented an application from Mrs Sala Faye Whittington for a beer and wine license for on premises service at McGuire's Family Restaurant.

ZONING - ERNEST S TANNER

Mr Tanner appeared before the Council to request a variance to upgrade his property by replacing an old trailer with a new one.

Mr Beall made a motion to grant the variance.

Mr Chason seconded the motion.

There was a discussion period.

Mr Beall, Mr Chason and Mrs Pierce voted in approval of the motion.

Mr Champion and Mr Hadley voted in opposition to the motion.

HISTORIC PRESERVATION - SALLY SHARPLESS

Ms Sharpless appeared before the Council to request that Mayor Teel appoint a committee to review the Spectrum plans.

Mayor Teel appointed Ms Pierce, Mr Dan Doulet and Mr Parker Jones to serve on this committee.

Mr Champion presented a report on recreation.

Mr Chris Tracy thanked the Council for use of the old lunchroom for his boxing program.
