BICYCLES ON SIDEWALKS

Mr Ed Yanko appeared before the Council to express concerns he has about bicyclists speeding down the sidewalks of Town and the possibility of people exiting the shops being hit by these cyclists.

Mr Yanko requested signage to enforce the bicycle code.

Mr Beall made a motion to reestablish the No Bikes on Sidewalk policy, and that signs be placed on the corners with a fine of not more than \$25.00.

Mrs Pierce seconded the motion.

Mr Champion, Mr Chason and Mr Hadley voted in agreement with the motion.

NEIGHBORHOOD WATCH

Mr Jim Stone appeared before the Council to request that the Town supply the posts and labor to install the Neighborhood Watch signs.

Mr Stone further asked that the second speed bump be installed.

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Mr Champion made a motion that the Town provide the poles and labor to install the signs.

Mr Hadley seconded the motion.

Mr Beall, Mr Chason and Mrs Pierce voted in agreement with the motion.

Mr Hadley made a motion that the meeting be adjourned.

Mrs Pierce seconded the motion.
