

A RESOLUTION
December 13, 1999

- WHEREAS** the governing officials of the Town of Pine Mountain have been informed that there is a great need for a new Post Office to serve the citizens of the Town of Pine Mountain; and
- WHEREAS** the Pine Mountain Post Office has for a century, been a general meeting place for the citizenry; and
- WHEREAS** a large number of our citizens walk to the Post Office daily; and
- WHEREAS** the downtown area of Pine Mountain is truly centrally located in the town; and
- WHEREAS** the relocation of post offices from downtown business districts has had a negative impact on the revitalization efforts which a number of cities throughout Georgia are undertaking, and
- WHEREAS** a post office located in any area other than downtown is a counter move to the development of growth of the central business district;
- NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** by the Mayor and Council that their desire is to have the new Post Office placed downtown where it will be pedestrian friendly and accessible to both citizens and those engaged in commercial activities.
