

ACTS OF THE COUNCIL

November 8, 1999

The Mayor and Council sat in regular session at seven o'clock P.M. on the evening of November 8, 1999 in the Town Hall.

Mayor Joe D. Teel, Jr. presided with Councilpersons J.R. Beall, William J. Champion, W. Mitchell Chason, C. Lamar Hadley and Tamara M. Pierce in attendance.

ACTS OF THE COUNCIL

Mr. Chason made a motion that the acts of October, 1999 be approved as written. Mr. Hadley seconded the motion. Mr. Beall, Mr. Champion and Mrs. Pierce voted in favor of the motion.

FINANCIAL REPORTS

Mayor Teel presented the financial reports for October. Mr. Chason requested at next meeting have a report for half of the year budget.

PINE MOUNTAIN TOURISM-HANK ARNOLD

Ms. Arnold stated that there was no meeting for this month to report on.

PINE MOUNTAIN YOUTH SPORTS-ROBERT McGEE

Mr. McGee requested the use of the gym starting on November 29, 1999 at 5:30 P.M. until 8:30 or 9:00 P.M. until the middle of March for basketball practice. Mayor Teel said it was okay as long as no conflicts with any already on the books. There was no motion or votes on this discussion.

SIGNAGE-ROBERT EPSTEIN

Mr. Epstein ask permission to place a directional sign for the businesses by First Union and The Pine Mountain Tourism. Mr. Champion made a motion, Mrs. Pierce seconded the motion, Mr. Hadley, Mr. Chason in favor with Mr. Beall abstained.

PINE MOUNTAIN CHAMBER-ROBERT EPSTEIN

Stated that Friday November 19, 1999 at 5:30 will be the time for the Christmas lights to be turned on.

PARKS AND RECREATION-LAMAR HADLEY, BILL CHAMPION

Naming of the park by the gym to Old Chipley Park. Mr. Beall made motion, Mr. Chason seconded, Mrs. Pierce, Mr. Champion, Mr. Hadley all in favor.

Mr. Hadley ask for suggestions of names for the Park on Highway 27.

Mr. Hadley would like permission to seek Grants for Recreation Parks. Mrs. Pierce made a motion, Mr. Champion seconded, Mr. Chason in favor with Mr. Beall abstained.

COMMUNITY CENTER-BILL CHAMPION

Mr. Champion stated that the fees for renting the gym are as follows:

\$25.00 for 2 hours, \$10.00 for every hour after, 20% of revenue for larger groups. A \$50.00 deposit is required. A lease has to be signed which includes a waiver. Keys are to be signed out at the Town Hall. There was no motion and no votes on this decision.

Mr. Champion is seeking funds for outside work.

Mr. Champion suggested that Mike Testa be hired as Architect for Chipley Community Center. The fee is \$5,200. Mayor Teel stated that anything over \$5,000 has to be bided on. There was no motion and no votes on this.

WATER REQUEST-CHARLES ROBERTS

Mr. Roberts request that a water line be installed on Highway 27 to his residence. No motion or votes was made.

SPEEDING ON OAK AVENUE-SHERI CRAWFORD

Mrs. Crawford came to complain about speeding on Oak Avenue. She was assured that an officer would patrol that area.
