ACTS OF COUNCIL

SEPTIC TANK IN MOUNTAIN BROOK SUBDIVISION

Mr Jonathan Edwards came before the council requesting to place a septic tank in Mountain Brook Subdivision (Lot 6 Block F).

Mr Chason made a motion to grant his request. Mr Chason asked that Mayor Teel first write a letter to EPD to see if they would grant a waiver and allow Mr Edwards to connect to city sewer, if not, then fall back on the septic tank.
