ACTS OF COUNCIL

Mr Chason made a motion that the Acts of Council for November meeting be approved as written.

Mayor Teel presented the financial report for November.

PINE MOUNTAIN TOURISM

Ms Arnold advised the Mayor and Council the meeting for Tourism would be held on Wednesday at 2:00.

PINE MOUNTAIN HERITAGE

Mr Thompson presented the Mayor and Council petitions regarding unsightly property.

Petition 1 Location- The fenced in lot behind Cook Brothers Service Station. Also, the pile of used tires at the front of Cook Brothers Service Station.

Petition 2 Location- The vacant lot at the corner of Chipley Street and Cherry Avenue adjacent to the dry cleaners.

Petition 3 Location- The area behind San Marcos Mexican Restaurant.

Petition 4 Location- The area behind the used car lot on Highway 27, adjacent to Days Inn.

I do solemnly swear that I will well and truly perform the duties of Councilperson of the Town of Pine Mountain, Georgia.

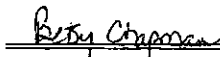
