The Mayor and Council of the Town of Pine Mountain sat in regular session on the evening of September 10, 2001 at seven o'clock P.M. in the Town Hall.

Mayor Joe D Teel, Jr presided with Councilperson W Mitchell Chason, Tamara M Pierce, Benny S Burdette in attendance. Jerry M Teasley and Barbara Bell Ewell were not present.

ACTS OF COUNCIL

Mr Chason made a motion that the Acts of Council for the August meetings be approved as written.

Mrs Pierce seconded the motion.

Mr Burdette, Mrs Pierce and Mr Chason voted in favor of the motion.

FINANCIAL REPORT

Mayor Teel presented the financial report for August.

Ms Arnold presented the Tracking Report for August.

PINE MOUNTAIN CHAMBER OF COMMERCE

Mr Snider came before the council requesting that a portion of the Commerce Street be closed for "Old Fashion Market Day" on October 13, 2001. The Chamber of Commerce accepted liability.

Mr Chason made a motion that the street be closed for "Old Fashion Day".

Mr Burdette seconded the motion.

Mrs Pierce, Mr Chason and Mr Burdette voted in favor of the motion.

PINE MOUNTAIN HERITAGE

Mrs Lynda Dawson came before Council on behalf of Pine Mountain Heritage, Inc. to ask that the February 12, 2001 minutes be amended to reflect the following: That the Pine Mountain Heritage, Inc. be designated the recipient of the \$100,000.00 beautification fund set aside by Pine Mountain Tourism Assoc. as was decided in the February 12, 2001 meeting; however, due to an oversight was not reflected in the minutes. Mrs Dawson also requested that the Mayor be allowed to execute the necessary paperwork as required by the Pine Mountain Tourism Association bylaws instead of requiring full council approval.

Mr Chason moved that the Town and/or Heritage be the designee of said beautification fund set aside by Pine Mountain Tourism Association.

Mrs Pierce seconded the motion.

Mr Burdette, Mr Chason and Mrs Pierce voted in favor of the motion.

Mr Chason also moved that the Mayor be allowed to execute the necessary paperwork for Pine Mountain Heritage, Inc. to draw funds as matched rather than requiring full council approval. Mrs Pierce seconded the motion. Mr Chason, Mrs Pierce and Mr Burdette voted in favor of the motion.

ORDINANCE CHANGE

Mr William McGuire came before the council requesting an ordinance amendment to section XX within the alcohol ordinance. Mr McGuire would like to open a sports bar & grill on Highway 27 in Pine Mountain. He would like to place pool tables, dart boards, and etc. within the business. The ordinance doesn't allow this at the present time. Mayor Teel presented the 1st reading on this request. Second reading will be held at the October meeting.
