TRUCK ROUTE FROM HWY 18 TO HWY 354

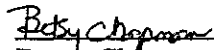
Mr Bruce Jones was not in attendance.

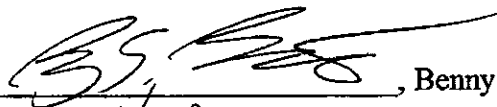
ADJOURMENT
