ACTS OF COUNCIL

A dedication service will be held on Saturday, September 27th, for Askew Park.

RAILROAD

Mr Askew requested that the Mayor and Council contact the Railroad Company to find out if they are going to abandon the RRR tracks. See if they are going to turn them over to the Town or exactly what is going to be done. He requested a bike trail be placed there.

LICENSING OF VENDORS

Mr Thompson asked if there is an ordinance that applies to vendors. Mayor Teel advised Mr Thompson if someone has a license in another Municipality they do not need to purchase one from here.

SIDEWALK ORDINANCE

Mr Thompson would like to place table on the sidewalk in front of Rose Cottage. He would like to see a sidewalk ordinance put in place.

Ms Pierce asked the Mayor to get the Town Attorney to draft a sidewalk ordinance that the police department can fairly enforce.
